## **PREFACE**

This report is issued on a monthly basis and aims at providing a general view of the external trade of Cyprus and its partner countries for October 2004. It is divided into three parts. Part A pertains to total trade statistics, Part B to Extra-EU trade statistics and Part C to Intra-EU trade statistics.

The statistics of trade with non-EU countries (Extra-EU trade) are compiled mainly from THESEAS system, the computerised system of Customs Authorities for imports and the Single Administrative Document for exports. The statistics of trade with EU countries (Intra-EU trade) are compiled via the INTRASTAT system and the data collected via the VAT returns.

The valuable cooperation of the Department of Customs and Excise and the VAT Service is acknowledged.

This report was prepared by the staff of the Foreign Trade Section, under the guidance of Ms Evi Kalogirou, Statistics Officer and the general supervision of Mr. George Zeitountsian, Senior Statistics Officer, Head of the National Accounts and Foreign Trade Sections.

## INTRODUCTION

### DEVELOPMENTS IN EXTERNAL TRADE IN OCTOBER 2004

**Total imports** (covering total imports from third countries and arrivals from E.U countries) in January-October 2004 amounted to £2.228,1 mn as compared to £1.905,4 mn in January-October 2003. **Total exports** (covering total exports to third countries and dispatches to other Member States) in January-October 2004 were £419,3 mn compared to £409,9 mn in January-October 2003. **The trade deficit** increased by 20,9% to £1.808,8 mn in January-October 2004 compared to £1.495,6 mn in the corresponding period of 2003.

#### ▪ EXTRA-EU TRADE

**Total imports from third countries** were £57,4 mn and **total exports to third countries, including stores and provisions**, £22,8 mn in October 2004. Domestic exports, including stores and provisions, were £7,2 mn whilst foreign exports, including stores and provisions, were £15,6 mn.

a. Total imports by H.S Section

Section V of Harmonized System 'Mineral products' being the main source of supply, accounted for £11,9 mn in October 2004, followed by Section XVII 'Vehicles, aircraft, vessels and associated transport equipment' with £10,4 mn and Section XVI 'Machinery and mechanical appliances' with £7,2 mn.

b. Total imports by area

Other Asian countries continued to be the main source of supply of goods to Cyprus from third countries with a share of £24,2 mn in October 2004. Major suppliers within were Japan contributing £7,8 mn, China with £7,0 mn, Thailand with £2,5 mn and Taiwan with £1,2 mn.

Imports from the United States of America accounted for £3,6 mn in October 2004.

c. Total exports, including stores and provisions, by H.S Section

Section XVI of Harmonized System 'Machinery and mechanical appliances' head the list with £10,2 mn, followed by Section XVIII ' Optical, photographic, cinematographic instruments' with £3,2 mn and Section VI 'Products of the chemical or allied industries' with £2,8 mn.

d. Total exports by area

Exports to the Near and Middle Eastern countries occupied the first place in importance with a share of £13,4 mn in October 2004. Our major customers within were the United Arab Emirates with £8,9 mn, Lebanon with £1,4 mn, Iraq with £0,9mn and Jordan with £0,6 mn.

#### ▪ INTRA-EU TRADE

**Arrivals from E.U countries** were £185,6 mn in October 2004, while **dispatches to other E.U countries** were £26,7 mn.

**a. Arrivals by H.S Section**

Section XVI of Harmonized System 'Machinery and mechanical appliances' head the list with £38,3 mn, followed by Section XVII 'Vehicles, aircraft, vessels and associated transport equipment' with £25,1 mn. Section VI 'Products of the chemical or allied industries' in October 2004 amounted to £17,3 mn, followed by Section XI 'Textiles and textile articles' with £14,8 mn.

Section V 'Mineral products' amounted to £13,5 mn in October 2004.

**a. Arrivals by area**

Within the European Union, our major suppliers in October 2004 were Greece with £42,5 mn, Italy with £29,6 mn, Germany with £21,6 mn and the United Kingdom with £20,7 mn.

**b. Dispatches by H.S Section**

Section XVI of Harmonized System 'Machinery and mechanical appliances' head the list with £10,9 mn, followed by Section XVII 'Vehicles, aircraft, vessels associated transport equipment' with £4,2 mn and Section VI 'Products of chemical or allied industries' with £2,2 mn

Section XV 'Base metal and articles of base metal' accounted to £1,2 mn in October 2004.

**c. Dispatches by area**

As regards dispatches, our main partner countries within the European Union in October 2004 were Greece with £6,2 mn, the United Kingdom with £6,1 mn, Germany with £5,4 mn and Denmark with £2,9 mn.

## DEFINITIONS OF TERMS USED

### Arrivals

"Arrivals" are analogous to imports.

Arrivals include:

- a) goods in free circulation which enter the statistical territory of Cyprus;
- b) goods which have been placed under the CUSTOMS procedure for inward processing or processing under CUSTOMS control (for processing, transformation or repair) in another Member State and which enter the statistical territory of Cyprus;
- c) Some goods movements are included in statistics based on specific conditions. In particular, aircraft and ships whose ownership has been transferred from a person established in another Member State to a person established in the Cyprus are included in the statistics of arrivals of Cyprus.

### Dispatches

"Dispatches" are analogous to exports.

Dispatches include:

- a) goods in free circulation which leave the statistical territory of Cyprus bound for another Member State;
- b) goods which have been placed under the CUSTOMS procedure for inward processing or processing under CUSTOMS control (for processing, transformation or repair) in Cyprus and which are destined for another Member State;
- c) Some goods movements are included in statistics based on specific conditions. In particular, aircraft and ships whose ownership has been transferred from a person established in the Cyprus to a person established in another Member State are included in the statistics on dispatches of Cyprus.

### Imports

Imports **under special trade system** include:

- a) Goods, which enter the statistical territory of Cyprus from a non-member country and are:

- Placed under the CUSTOMS procedure for release into free circulation (goods intended to be consumed in Cyprus or dispatched to another Member State), either immediately or after a period in a CUSTOMS warehouse or
- Placed under the CUSTOMS procedure for inward processing or processing under CUSTOMS control (usually goods destined to be processed, transformed or repaired for subsequent re-export) either immediately or after a period in a CUSTOMS warehouse.

- b) Some movements of goods are included in statistics based on specific conditions. In particular aircraft and ships whose ownership has been transferred from a person established in a non-member country to a person established in Cyprus are included in import statistics of Cyprus.

### Exports

Exports **under special trade system** include:

- a) goods that leave the statistical territory of Cyprus bound for a non-member country, having gone through:

- The CUSTOMS export procedure (final export, export following inward processing, etc.); or
- The CUSTOMS outward-processing procedure (usually goods destined to be processed, transformed or repaired for subsequent re-import).

<b>The Harmonized Commodity Description and Coding System (HS)</b>	<b>Partner country</b>
<p>The Harmonised System is a legal instrument adopted by the Customs Co-operation Council (now the World Customs Organisation) in June 1983 and the International Convention on the Harmonised System (HS Convention) entered into force on the 1<sup>st</sup> January 1988.</p>	<p>For exports and dispatches, the trading partner is the country (or Member State) of final destination of the goods. The last country to which the goods are specifically directed on their outward movement from the State is regarded as their final destination. This is not necessarily the country in which the good will be unshipped or that in which they will be finally consumed.</p>

According to the HS Convention, the HS "means the Nomenclature comprising the headings and the subheadings and their related numerical codes, the Section, Chapter and Subheadings notes and the General Rules for the interpretation of the Harmonised System". The HS is designed as a "multipurpose nomenclature", to be used for transportable goods. Both HS and CN are therefore concerned heavily with the nature or material of the product.

**The shape of the HS and the CN classifications is illustrated in the following table:**

**Country classification**

The classification of countries is the country nomenclature (Geonomenclature) as set annually in the Official Journal of the European Communities. The full list of countries is given in an essentially geographical order in Table 4, Part A, Total trade statistics.

For imports (extra-EU trade), the trading partner is the country of origin. In general, goods obtained entirely from a given country originate in that country. A product, in the production of which two or more countries were concerned, is considered as originating in the country in which the last transformation or substantial processing took place. Packing repacking, sorting and blending are not regarded as manufacturing processes.

For arrivals (intra-EU trade), the trading partner is the Member State of consignment of the goods.

**Trade systems**

There are broadly two approaches, closely linked with customs procedures, used for the measurement of international trade in goods: the general trade system and the special trade system.

**General trade system**

The general trade system is the wider concept and under it the recorded aggregates include all goods entering or leaving the economic territory of a country with the exception of simple transit trade. In particular all goods which are received into customs warehouses are recorded as imports at that stage whether or not they subsequently go into free circulation in the Member State of receipt. Similarly, outgoing goods from customs warehouses are included in the general trade aggregates at the time they leave the Member State.

## **Special trade system**

The special trade system is a narrower concept. Goods from a foreign country which are received into customs warehouse are not recorded in the special trade aggregates unless they subsequently go into free circulation in the country of receipt (or are placed under the customs procedures for inward processing). Similarly, outgoing goods from customs warehouses are not recorded as exports.

## **Stores and provisions**

Stores and provisions denote ships' and aircraft's stores and supplies.

- ships and aircraft's stores' means the various products for consumption by the crew and passengers of vessels or aircraft;
- ships and aircraft's supplies' means the products for the operation of the engines, machines and other equipment on vessels or aircraft, such as fuel, oil and lubricants.

## **Domestic and foreign goods**

Domestic goods are goods originating in the economic territory of Cyprus; if they have been wholly obtained in it or were substantially transformed by processing in it, so that the processing confers domestic origin. Goods originally imported and having undergone only repair or minor operations which leave them essentially unchanged are not defined as domestic. Minor operations include blending, packaging, bottling, cleaning, sorting, husking and selling.

Foreign goods are goods originating in the rest of the world, i.e not included in the economic territory of Cyprus and compensating goods obtained under the outward processing procedure when such processing confers foreign origin.
