PREFACE

This report is issued on a monthly basis and aims at providing a general view of the external trade of Cyprus and its partner countries for **Β' τριμήνου 2009**. It is divided into three parts. Part A pertains to total trade statistics under the general trade system, Part B to Extra-EU trade statistics under the special trade system and Part C to Intra-EU trade statistics. All values shown in the tables of this report are in Euros.

The statistics of trade with non-EU countries (Extra-EU trade) are compiled mainly from THESEAS system, the computerised system of Customs Authorities for imports and the Single Administrative Document for exports. The statistics of trade with EU countries (Intra-EU trade) are compiled via the INTRASTAT system and the data collected via the VAT returns.

The valuable cooperation of the Department of Customs and Excise and the VAT Service is acknowledged.

This report was prepared by the staff of the Foreign Trade Section, under the guidance of Mrs Evi Kalogirou, Statistics Officer and the general supervision of Mr. George Zeitountsian, **7^{ος} Αντιπρόεδρος** Statistics Officer, Head of the National Accounts and Foreign Trade Sections.

INTRODUCTION

DEVELOPMENTS IN EXTERNAL TRADE FOR NOVEMBER 2009

Total imports/arrivals (covering total imports from third countries and arrivals from E.U countries) in November 2009 amounted to €484,9mn as compared to €599,3mn in November 2008. **Total exports/dispatches** (covering total exports to third countries and dispatches to other Member States) in November 2009 were €76,5mn compared to €110,9mn in November 2008. As a result of the above developments the trade deficit was €408,4mn in November 2009 compared to €488,4mn in the corresponding month of 2008.

Total imports/arrivals

Imported goods were €484,9mn in November 2009 and €599,3mn in November 2008.

a. **Total imports/arrivals by H.S Section**

Section XVI 'Machinery, electrical equipment and parts' head the list with €87,1mn followed by Section V 'Mineral products' with €75,5mn, Section IV 'Prepared foodstuffs, beverages, spirits and vinegar, tobacco and manufactured tobacco substitutes' with €50,1mn, Section VI 'Products of the chemical or allied industry' with €45,7mn and Section XVII 'Vehicles, aircraft, vessels and associated transport equipment' with €42,6mn.

b. **Total imports/arrivals by economic destination**

- Consumer goods valued at €166,3mn or 34,3% in November 2009 and €184,4mn or 30,8% in the respective month of 2008.
- Intermediate inputs valued at €142,5mn or 29,4% as against €152,5mn or 25,4% in November 2008. The manufacturing sector absorbed €80,8mn as compared with €83,2mn in November 2008. Raw materials for the construction sector were €28,2mn in November 2009 and €32,2mn in November 2008.
- Fuels and lubricants, including crude petroleum oil, valued at €74,7mn in November 2009 and €102,1mn in the corresponding month of 2008.
- Capital goods valued at €51,8mn in November 2009 and €57,7mn in November 2008. The manufacturing sector was €12,9mn in November 2009 as against €11,7mn in November 2008. Capital goods for the construction and mining sectors valued at €7,1mn in November 2009 and €12,8mn in November 2008. The transport, storage and communication sector absorbed €8,0mn as against €6,9mn in November 2008. Capital goods for agriculture accounted for €2,3mn in November 2009 and €3,2mn in the corresponding month of 2008.
- Transport equipment with their parts accounted for €49,4mn in November 2009 as compared with €88,6mn in November 2008.

c. **Total imports/arrivals by area**

- The European Union continued to be the main source of supply of goods to Cyprus in November 2009, with a share of €347,7mn of total imports/arrivals. Major suppliers within the Union were Greece with €104,5mn, Italy €53,8mn, Germany €46,0mn and the United Kingdom €39,5mn.

- Imports from all other European countries totaled €11,9mn in November 2009.
- Imports from the rest of the world in November 2009 amounted to €125,3mn with Israel contributing €37,1mn, China (People's Republic of) with €35,5mn, Japan with €7,6mn, Thailand with €2,9mn, the United Arab Emirates with €2,4mn and Taiwan with €1,9mn.

Total imports/arrivals destined for home use

Imported goods destined for home use were €461,3mn in November 2009 and €563,6mn in November 2008.

a. Imports/arrivals destined for home use by economic destination

- Consumer goods valued at €158,4mn or 34,3% and €176,8mn or 31,4% in November 2009 and in November 2008, accordingly.
- Intermediate inputs valued at €138,9mn or 30,1% as against €148,4mn or 26,3% in November 2008. The manufacturing sector absorbed €79,9mn as compared with €81,6mn in November 2008. Raw materials for the construction sector were €28,3mn in November 2009 and €32,4mn in November 2008.
- Fuels and lubricants, including crude petroleum oil, valued at €66,4mn in November 2009 and €91,9mn in the corresponding month of 2008.
- Capital goods valued at €50,9mn in November 2009 and €53,5mn in November 2008. The manufacturing sector was €12,9mn in November 2009 as against €11,6mn in November 2008. Capital goods for the construction and mining sectors valued at €6,9mn in November 2009 and €9,5mn in November 2008. The transport, storage and communication sector absorbed €7,9mn as against €6,7mn in November 2008. Capital goods for agriculture accounted for €2,3mn in November 2009 and €3,2mn the respective month of 2008.
- Transport equipment with their parts accounted for €46,5mn in November 2009 as compared with €79,1mn in November 2008.

Total exports/dispatches

Total exports/dispatches, including stores and provisions, accounted for €76,5mn as compared with €110,9mn in November 2008. Total exports/dispatches of domestically produced goods, including stores and provisions, were €40,9mn in November 2009 whilst total exports/dispatches of foreign goods, including stores and provisions, were €35,6mn.

a. Total exports/dispatches, including stores and provisions, by H.S Section

Section VI 'Products of the chemical or allied industries' head the list with €20,3mn followed by Section V 'Mineral products' with €11,1mn, Section XVI 'Machinery, electrical equipment and parts' with €11,1mn and Section IV 'Prepared foodstuffs; beverage, spirits and vinegar, tobacco and manufactured tobacco substitutes' with €6,7mn.

b. Total exports/dispatches of domestically produced goods, excluding stores and provisions, by category

- Industrial products of domestic produce exported during November 2009 valued at €35,6mn and €34,2mn in November 2008.
- Exports/dispatches of raw agricultural products valued at €4,5mn or 11,0% in November 2009 and €24,0mn or 40,9% in the corresponding month of 2008.
- Mineral exports valued at €0,7mn or 1,8% in November 2009 and €0,5mn or 0,9% in November 2008.

c. Total exports/dispatches by area

- Dispatches to the European Union accounted for €40,7mn in November 2009 of the total exports/dispatches. Dispatches to Greece accounted for €19,8mn, to Germany €5,3mn and to the United Kingdom for €5,2mn.
- Exports to Near and Middle Eastern countries occupied the second place in importance with €10,6mn for the month in reference.
- Exports to all other European countries followed in importance with €1,7mn.
- Exports to the Asian countries in November 2009 amounted with €6,9mn.
- Exports to the rest of the world accounted for November 2009 accounted to €6,4mn.
- Stores and provisions in November 2009 valued at €10,2mn.

APPENDIX

DEFINITIONS OF TERMS USED

Arrivals

"Arrivals" are analogous to imports.

Arrivals include:

- a) goods in free circulation which enter the statistical territory of Cyprus;
- b) goods which have been placed under the CUSTOMS procedure for inward processing or processing under CUSTOMS control (for processing, transformation or repair) in another Member State and which enter the statistical territory of Cyprus.
- c) Some goods movements are included in statistics based on specific conditions. In particular, aircraft and ships whose ownership has been transferred from a person established in another Member State to a person established in the Cyprus are included in the statistics of arrivals of Cyprus.

Dispatches

"Dispatches" are analogous to exports.

Dispatches include:

- a) goods in free circulation which leave the statistical territory of Cyprus bound for another Member State;
- b) goods which have been placed under the CUSTOMS procedure for inward processing or processing under CUSTOMS control (for processing, transformation or repair) in Cyprus and which are destined for another Member State.
- c) Some goods movements are included in statistics based on specific conditions. In particular, aircraft and ships whose ownership has been transferred from a person established in the Cyprus to a person established in another Member State are included in the statistics on dispatches of Cyprus.

Imports

Imports **under special trade system** include:

a) Goods, which enter the statistical territory of Cyprus from a non-member country and are:

- Placed under the CUSTOMS procedure for release into free circulation (goods intended to be consumed in Cyprus or dispatched to another Member State), either immediately or after a period in a CUSTOMS warehouse or
- Placed under the CUSTOMS procedure for inward processing or processing under CUSTOMS control (usually goods destined to be processed, transformed or repaired for subsequent re-export) either immediately or after a period in a CUSTOMS warehouse.

b) Some movements of goods are included in statistics based on specific conditions. In particular, aircraft and ships whose ownership has been transferred from a person established in a non-member country to a person established in Cyprus are included in import statistics of Cyprus.

Exports

Exports **under special trade system** include:

a) goods that leave the statistical territory of Cyprus bound for a non-member country, having gone through:

- The CUSTOMS export procedure (final export, export following inward processing, etc.); or
- The CUSTOMS outward-processing procedure (usually goods destined to be processed, transformed or repaired for subsequent re-import).

The Harmonized Commodity Description and Coding System (HS)

The Harmonised System is a legal instrument adopted by the Customs Co-operation Council (now the World Customs Organisation) in June 1983 and the International Convention on the Harmonised System (H.S. Convention) entered into force on the 1st January 1988.

According to the H.S. Convention, the HS "means the Nomenclature comprising the headings and the subheadings and their related numerical codes, the Section, Chapter and Subheadings notes and the General Rules for the interpretation of the Harmonised System". The H.S. is designed as a "multipurpose nomenclature", to be used for transportable goods. Both H.S. and C.N. are therefore concerned heavily with the nature or material of the product.

The shape of the H.S. and the C.N. classifications is illustrated in the following table:

The general structure of HS is as follows:

Sections I-IV: Agricultural products

Sections V-VII: Minerals, chemicals and related products, plastics, rubber and articles thereof

Sections VIII-X: Animal products, such as hides, skins and furskins, as well as wood, cork, pulp, paper and articles thereof

Sections XI-XII: Textile, footwear and headgear

Sections XIII-XV: Articles of stone, plaster, cement, asbestos, mica and the like, ceramic products, glass, pearls, precious or semi-precious stones, precious metals, jewellery, base metals and articles thereof

Section XVI: Machinery, mechanical appliances and electrical equipment

Section XVII: Vehicles, aircraft, vessels and associated transport equipment

Section XVIII: Optical, photographic, cinematographic, measuring, checking, precision, medical or surgical instruments and apparatus, clocks and watches, musical instruments

Section XIX: Arms and ammunition

Sections XX-XXI: Miscellaneous manufactured articles, such as furniture, lighting fittings, prefabricated buildings, sports requisites, works of art, collectors' pieces and antiques

Trade systems

There are broadly two approaches, closely linked with customs procedures, used for the measurement of international trade in goods: the general trade system and the special trade system.

General trade system

The general trade system is the wider concept and under it the recorded aggregates include all goods entering or leaving the economic territory of Cyprus with the exception of simple transit trade. In particular all goods which are received into customs warehouses are recorded as imports at that stage whether or not they subsequently go into free circulation in Cyprus. Similarly, outgoing goods from customs warehouses are included in the general trade aggregates at the time they leave Cyprus.

Special trade system

The special trade system is a narrower concept. Goods from a foreign country which are received into customs warehouse are not recorded in the special trade aggregates unless they subsequently go into free circulation in Cyprus (or are placed under the customs procedures for inward processing). Similarly, outgoing goods from customs warehouses are not recorded as exports.

Partner country

For exports and dispatches, the trading partner is the country (or Member State) of final destination of the goods. The last country to which the goods are specifically directed on their outward movement from the State is regarded as their final destination. This is not necessarily the country in which the good will be unshipped or that in which they will be finally consumed.

For imports (extra-EU trade), the trading partner is the country of origin. In general, goods obtained entirely from a given country originate in that country. A product, in the production of which two or more countries were concerned, is considered as originating in the country in which the last transformation or substantial processing took place. Packing repacking, sorting and blending are not regarded as manufacturing processes.

For arrivals (intra-EU trade), the trading partner is the Member State of consignment of the goods.

Country classification

The classification of countries is the country nomenclature (Geonomenclature) as set annually in the Official Journal of the European Communities.

Stores and provisions

Stores and provisions denote ships' and aircraft's stores and supplies.

- ships' and aircraft's stores' means the various products for consumption by the crew and

passengers of vessels or aircraft;

- ships and aircraft's supplies' means the products for the operation of the engines, machines and other equipment on vessels or aircraft, such as fuel, oil and lubricants.

Domestic and foreign goods

Domestic goods are goods originating in the economic territory of Cyprus; if they have been wholly obtained in it or were substantially transformed by processing in it, so that the processing confers domestic origin. Goods originally imported and having undergone only repair or minor operations which leave them essentially unchanged are not defined as domestic. Minor operations include blending, packaging, bottling, cleaning, sorting, husking and selling.

Foreign goods are goods originating in the rest of the world, i.e not included in the economic territory of Cyprus and compensating goods obtained under the outward processing procedure when such processing confers foreign origin.
