PREFACE

This report is issued on a monthly basis and aims at providing a general view of the external trade of Cyprus and its partner countries for December 2005. It is divided into three parts. Part A pertains to total trade statistics under the general trade system, Part B to Extra-EU trade statistics under the special trade system and Part C to Intra-EU trade statistics.

The statistics of trade with non-EU countries (Extra-EU trade) are compiled mainly from THESEAS system, the computerised system of Customs Authorities for imports and the Single Administrative Document for exports. The statistics of trade with EU countries (Intra-EU trade) are compiled via the INTRASTAT system and the data collected via the VAT returns.

The valuable cooperation of the Department of Customs and Excise and the VAT Service is acknowledged.

This report was prepared by the staff of the Foreign Trade Section, under the guidance of Ms Evi Kalogirou, Statistics Officer and the general supervision of Mr. George Zeitountsian, Senior Statistics Officer, Head of the National Accounts and Foreign Trade Sections.

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INTRODUCTION

DEVELOPMENTS IN EXTERNAL TRADE FOR DECEMBER 2005

Total imports/arrivals (covering total imports from third countries and arrivals from E.U countries) in December 2005 amounted to £273,3mn as compared to £263,9mn in December 2004. **Total exports/dispatches** (covering total exports to third countries and dispatches to other Member States) in December 2005 were £56,9mn compared to £47,5mn in December 2004. As a result of the above developments the trade deficit was £216,4mn in December 2005 compared to £216,4mn in the corresponding month of 2004.

Total imports/arrivals

Imported goods were £273,3mn in December 2005 and £263,9mn in December 2004.

a. Total imports/arrivals by H.S Section

Section XVI 'Machinery, electrical equipment and parts' head the list with £57,7mn, followed by Section V 'Mineral products' with £36,9mn, Section XVII 'Vehicles, aircraft, vessels and associated transport equipment' with £36,5mn and Section XV 'Base metal and articles of base metal' with £21,2mn.

b. Total imports/arrivals by economic destination

- Consumer goods head the list with £84,1mn or 30,8% in December 2005 and £69,4mn or 26,3% in December 2004.
- Intermediate inputs destined for the local market valued at £76,5mn or 28,0% as against £77,0mn or 29,2% in December 2004. The manufacturing sector absorbed £39,0mn as compared with £43,1mn in December 2004. Raw materials for the construction sector were £21,2mn in December 2005 and £20,7mn in December 2004.
- Transport equipment with their parts accounted for £39,1mn as compared with £41,1mn in December 2004.
- Fuels and lubricants, including crude petroleum oil, valued at £36,3mn in December 2005 and £49,2mn in the corresponding month of 2004.
- Capital goods valued at £29,8mn in December 2005 and £24,9mn in December 2004. The transport, storage and communication sector, occupying the first place in importance, absorbed £5,0mn as against £5,2mn in December 2004. The manufacturing sector was £6,8mn in December 2005 as against £6,2mn in December 2004. Capital goods destined for the construction and mining sectors valued at £2,7mn in December 2005 and at £2,0mn in December 2004. Capital goods for agriculture accounted for £1,3mn in December 2005 and £0,8mn in the corresponding month of 2004.

c. **Total imports/arrivals by area**

- The European Union continued to be the main source of supply of goods to Cyprus in December 2005, with a share of £192,5mn or 70,4% of total imports/arrivals. Major suppliers within the Union were Greece with £57,9mn, Germany £26,4mn, Italy £25,7mn, and the United Kingdom £22,0mn.
- Imports from all other European countries totaled £16,3mn in December 2005.
- Imports from the rest of the world in December 2005 amounted to £64,5mn with Japan contributing £9,9mn, China (People's Republic of) £9,5mn, the United Arab Emirates £3,2mn and Israel £7,0mn.

Imports/Arrivals destined for home use

Imported goods destined for home use were £241,2mn in December 2005 and £250,1mn in December 2004.

a. **Imports/Arrivals destined for home use by economic destination**

- Consumer goods head the list with £68,8mn or 28,5% in December 2005 and £63,5mn or 25,4% in December 2004.
- Intermediate inputs destined for the local market valued at £75,0mn or 31,1% as against £77,0mn or 30,8% in December 2004. The manufacturing sector absorbed £38,4mn as compared with £43,0mn in December 2004. Raw materials for the construction sector were £21,3mn in December 2005 and £20,8mn in December 2004.
- Fuels and lubricants, including crude petroleum oil, valued at £32,1mn in December 2005 and £50,7mn in the corresponding month of 2004.
- Capital goods valued at £29,0mn in December 2005 and £24,4mn in December 2004. The manufacturing sector was £6,8mn in December 2005 as against £6,2mn in December 2004. The transport, storage and communication sector absorbed £4,3mn as against £5,0mn in December 2004. Capital goods destined for the construction and mining sectors valued at £2,7mn in December 2005 and at £2,0mn in December 2004. Capital goods for agriculture accounted for £1,3mn in December 2005 and £0,8mn in the corresponding month of 2004.
- Transport equipment with their parts accounted for £28,8mn as compared with £32,3mn in December 2004.

Total exports/dispatches

Total exports/dispatches including stores and provisions, accounted for £56,9mn as compared with £47,5mn in December 2004. Total exports/dispatches of domestically produced goods, including stores and provisions, were £19,9mn in December 2005 whilst total exports/dispatches of foreign goods, including stores and provisions, were £37,0mn.

a. Total exports/dispatches, including stores and provisions, by H.S Section

Section XVI 'Machinery, electrical equipment and parts' head the list with £18,5mn, followed by Section V 'Mineral products' with £8,7mn and Section VI 'Products of the chemical or allied industries' with £6,5mn.

b. Total exports/dispatches of domestically produced goods, excluding stores and provisions, by category

- Industrial products of domestic produce exported during December 2005 accounted for £13,8mn or 73,1% whereas industrial products of domestic produce exported during December 2004 were £16,2mn or 77,2%. Major export earners within December 2005 were pharmaceutical products £4,8mn, photosensitive semiconductor devices £0,8mn, furniture £0,4mn and articles of paper or of paperboard £0,3mn.
- Exports/dispatches of raw agricultural products valued at £4,8mn or 25,3% in December 2005 and £4,5mn or 21,5% in the corresponding month of 2004.
- Mineral exports valued at £0,3mn or 1,4% in December 2005 and £0,3mn or 1,3% in December 2004.

c. Total exports/dispatches by area

- Dispatches to the European Union accounted for £34,7mn in December 2005 constituting thus 61,0% of the total exports/dispatches. Dispatches to France accounted for £13,5mn, to the United Kingdom for £8,4mn and to Greece for £7,3mn.
- Exports to Near and Middle Eastern countries in December 2005 occupied the second place in importance with £5,0mn.
- Exports to all other European countries amounted to £2,7mn.
- Exports to the rest of the world were £5,6mn.
- Stores and provisions in December 2005 valued at £8,9mn.

- The CUSTOMS outward-processing procedure (usually goods destined to be processed, transformed or repaired for subsequent re-import).

Special trade system

The special trade system is a narrower concept. Goods from a foreign country which are received into customs warehouse are not recorded in the special trade aggregates unless they subsequently go into free circulation in Cyprus (or are placed under the customs procedures for inward processing). Similarly, outgoing goods from customs warehouses are not recorded as exports.

Stores and provisions

Stores and provisions denote ships' and aircraft's stores and supplies.

- ships and aircraft's stores' means the various products for consumption by the crew and passengers of vessels or aircraft;
- ships and aircraft's supplies' means the products for the operation of the engines, machines and other equipment on vessels or aircraft, such as fuel, oil and lubricants.

Domestic and foreign goods

Domestic goods are goods originating in the economic territory of Cyprus; if they have been wholly obtained in it or were substantially transformed by processing in it, so that the processing confers domestic origin. Goods originally imported and having undergone only repair or minor operations which leave them essentially unchanged are not defined as domestic. Minor operations include blending, packaging, bottling, cleaning, sorting, husking and selling.

Foreign goods are goods originating in the rest of the world, i.e. not included in the economic territory of Cyprus and compensating goods obtained under the outward processing procedure when such processing confers foreign origin.
