PREFACE

This report is issued on a monthly basis and aims at providing a general view of the external trade of Cyprus and its partner countries for February 2017. It is divided into three parts. Part A pertains to total trade statistics under the general trade system, Part B to Extra-EU trade statistics under the special trade system and Part C to Intra-EU trade statistics. All values shown in the tables of this report are in Euros.

The statistics of trade with non-EU countries (Extra-EU trade) are compiled mainly from 'THESEAS' system, the computerized system of Customs Authorities for imports and the customs exports computerized system. The statistics of trade with EU countries (Intra-EU trade) are compiled mainly via the Intrastat system and the data collected via the VAT returns.

This report was prepared by Mrs. I. Leontiou, Statistics Officer, under the guidance of Mr. S. Vikis, Statistics Officer A' and under the general supervision of Mr. S. Karagiorgis, Senior Statistics Officer, Head of Foreign Trade Division.

INTRODUCTION

DEVELOPMENTS IN EXTERNAL TRADE FOR FEBRUARY 2017

Total imports/arrivals (covering total imports from third countries and arrivals from E.U. countries) in January-February 2017 amounted to €1.147,2mn as compared to €820,2mn in January-February 2016. **Total exports/dispatches** (covering total exports to third countries and dispatches to other E.U. Member States) in January-February 2017 were €344,4mn compared to €522,2mn in January-February 2016. As a result of the above developments the trade deficit was €802,8mn in January-February 2017 compared to €298,0mn in the corresponding month of 2016.

Total imports/arrivals

Imported goods were €521,5mn in February 2017 and €397,7mn in February 2016.

a. Total imports/arrivals by H.S Section

Section XVII 'Vehicles, aircraft, vessels and associated transport equipment' lead the list with &131,3mn followed by Section V 'Mineral products' with &111,0mn, Section XVI 'Machinery, electrical equipment and parts' with &48,2mn, Section IV 'Prepared foodstuffs, beverages, spirits and vinegar, tobacco and manufactured tobacco substitutes' with &47,6mn, Section VI 'Products of the chemical or allied industries' with &46,2mn, Section XI 'Textiles and textile articles' with &19,6mn, Section VII 'Plastics and articles thereof' with &15,6mn, Section II 'Vegetable products' with &15,5mn, Section XV 'Base metal and articles of base metal' with &15,4mn and Section I 'Live animals, animal products' with &15,3mn.

b. Total imports/arrivals by economic destination

- Consumer goods valued at €141,8mn or 27,2% in February 2017 and €150,1mn or 37,7% in the respective month of 2016.
- Intermediate inputs valued at €97,4mn or 18,7% in February 2017 as against €97,4mn or 24,5% in February 2016. The manufacturing sector absorbed €62,3mn in February 2017 as compared with €62,1mn in February 2016. Raw materials for the construction sector were €13,9mn in February 2017 and €14,5mn in February 2016.
- Fuels and lubricants, including crude petroleum oil, valued at €110,6mn in February 2017 and €49,6mn in the corresponding month of 2016.
- Transport equipment with their parts accounted for €142,3mn in February 2017 as compared with €74,1mn in February 2016. Ships, boats and floating structures valued at €93,2mn in February 2017 as compared with €39,0mn in February 2016. Passenger motor vehicles were €29,8mn in February 2017 and €21,7mn in February 2016.
- Capital goods valued at €24,5mn in February 2017 and €24,6mn in February 2016. The manufacturing sector was €3,2mn in February 2017 as against €5,3mn in February 2016. Capital goods for the construction and mining sectors valued at €2,8mn in February 2017 and €1,4mn in February 2016. The transport, storage and communication sector valued at €4,7n in the February 2017 and €4,1mn in February 2016. Capital goods for agriculture accounted for €0,5mn in February 2017 and €1,0mn in the corresponding month of 2016.

c. Total imports/arrivals by area

- The European Union continued to be the main source of supply of goods to Cyprus in February 2017, with a share of €338,3mn of total imports/arrivals. Major suppliers within the Union were Greece with €123,4mn, Germany with €32,9mn, Italy with €36,1mn, Croatia with €29,6mn, the

United Kingdom with $\&cite{c}26,9mn$, Belgium with $\&cite{c}21,1mn$, Spain with $\&cite{c}14,6mn$ and the Netherlands with $\&cite{c}14,5mn$.

- Imports from all other European countries totaled €30,6mn in February 2017 with Norway €17,2mn, Ukraine with €3,1mn and Switzerland with €3,1mn,.
- Imports from the rest of the world in February 2017 amounted to €152,6mn with China (Republic of) €35,0mn, Israel €24,0mn, Panama with €15,7mn, Saudi Arabia with €12,6mn, Japan with €6,5mn, Viet-Nam with €3,5mn, the United States with €3,1mn, Argentina with €2,8mn and India €2,7mn.

d. Total imports/arrivals destined for home use

Imported goods destined for home use were €472,6mn in February 2017 and €377,0mn in February 2016.

Imports/arrivals destined for home use by economic destination

- Consumer goods valued at €132,6mn or 28,1% and €141,3mn or 37,5% in February 2017 and February 2016, accordingly.
- Intermediate inputs valued at €92,4mn or 19,5% in February 2017 as against €94,6mn or 25,1% in February 2016. The manufacturing sector absorbed €58,5mn in February 2017 and €60,1mn in February 2016.
- Fuels and lubricants, including crude petroleum oil, valued at €88,2mn in February 2017 and €43,0mn in the corresponding month of 2016.
- Transport equipment with their parts accounted for €131,6mn in February 2017 as compared with €72,2mn in February 2016. Ships, boats and floating structures valued at €93,2mn in February 2017 as compared with €39,0mn in February 2016. Passenger motor vehicles were €25,9mn in February 2017 and €20,0mn in February 2016.
- Capital goods valued at €22,9mn in February 2017 and €23,8mn in February 2016. The manufacturing sector was €3,1mn in February 2017 as against €5,3mn in February 2016. Capital goods for the construction and mining sectors valued at €2,6mn in February 2017 and €1,3mn in February 2016. The transport, storage and communication sector absorbed €4,1mn in February 2017 as against €3,8mn in February 2016. Capital goods for agriculture accounted for €0,5mn in February 2017 and €1,0mn the respective month of 2016.

Total exports/dispatches

Total exports/dispatches, including stores and provisions, accounted for €171,9mn in February 2017 as compared with €213,7mn in February 2016.

a. Total exports/dispatches, including stores and provisions, by H.S Section

Section V 'Mineral products' lead the list with €35,7mn followed by Section XVI 'Machinery electrical equipment and parts' with €30,4mn, Section VI 'Products of the chemical or allied industries' with €28,4mn, Section XVII 'Vehicles, aircraft, vessels and associated transport equipment' with €22,5mn, Section I 'Live animals, animal products' with €15,7mn, Section IV 'Prepared foodstuffs, beverages, spirits and vinegar, tobacco and manufactured tobacco substitutes' with €10,5mn, Section II 'Vegetable products' with €9,4mn, Section XVIII 'Optical, photographic, cinematographic, medical and surgical instruments, musical instruments, etc.' with €4,8mn and Section XV 'Base metal and articles of base metal' with €4,5mn.

b. Total exports/dispatches of domestically produced goods, excluding stores and provisions, by category

- Industrial products of domestic produce exported during February 2017 valued at €73,9mn and €55,4mn in February 2016.
- Exports/dispatches of raw agricultural products valued at €10,4mn or 12,3% in February 2017 and €10,6mn or 15,8% in the corresponding month of 2016.
- Mineral exports valued at €0,2mn or 0,2% in February 2017 and €0,4mn or 0,7% in February 2016.

c. Total exports/dispatches by area

- Dispatches to the European Union accounted for €63,9mn in February 2017 of the total exports/dispatches. Dispatches to the United Kingdom for €17,9mn, to Greece accounted for €16,5mn, to Germany for €5,5mn, to Czech Republic with €4,6mn, to Sweden with €2,6mn, to Bulgaria with €2,4mn, to Slovakia with €2,0mn and to Italy with €2,0mn.
- Exports to Near and Middle Eastern countries occupied the second place in importance with €20,9mn for February 2017.
- Exports to the Asian countries in February 2017 amounted to €13,4mn.
- Exports to all other European countries in February 2017 followed in importance with €6,8mn.
- Exports to countries and territories not specified in February 2017 amounted to €6,9mn, stores and provisions in February 2017 valued at €15,7mn.





DEFINITIONS OF TERMS USED

Arrivals

"Arrivals" are analogous to imports.

Arrivals include:

- a) goods in free circulation which enter the statistical territory of Cyprus;
- b) goods which have been placed under the CUSTOMS procedure for inward processing or processing under CUSTOMS control (for processing, transformation) in another Member State and which enter the statistical territory of Cyprus.
- c) Some goods movements are included in statistics based on specific conditions e.g. aircrafts and ships whose ownership has been transferred from a person established in another Member State to a person established in the Cyprus are included in the statistics of arrivals of Cyprus.

Dispatches

"Dispatches" are analogous to exports.

Dispatches include:

- a) goods in free circulation which leave the statistical territory of Cyprus bound for another Member State;
- b) goods which have been placed under the CUSTOMS procedure for inward processing or processing under CUSTOMS control (for processing, transformation) in Cyprus and which are destined for another Member State.
- c) Some goods movements are included in statistics based on specific conditions. In particular, aircraft and ships whose ownership has been transferred from a person established in the Cyprus to a person established in another Member State are included in the statistics on dispatches of Cyprus.

Imports

Imports under special trade system include:

- a) Goods, which enter the statistical territory of Cyprus from a non-member country and are:
 - Placed under the CUSTOMS procedure for release into free circulation (goods intended to be consumed in Cyprus or dispatched to another Member State), either immediately or after a period in a CUSTOMS warehouse or
 - Placed under the CUSTOMS procedure for inward processing or processing under CUSTOMS control (usually goods destined to be processed, transformed for subsequent re-export) either immediately or after a period in a CUSTOMS warehouse.
- b) Some movements of goods are included in statistics based on specific conditions e.g aircrafts and ships whose ownership has been transferred from a person established in a non-member country to a person established in Cyprus are included in import statistics of Cyprus.

Exports

Exports under special trade system include:

- a) goods that leave the statistical territory of Cyprus bound for a non-member country, having gone through:
 - The CUSTOMS export procedure (final export, export following inward processing, etc.); or
 - The CUSTOMS outwardprocessing procedure (usually goods destined to be processed, transformed for subsequent re-import).

The Harmonized Commodity Description and Coding System (HS)

The Harmonised System is a legal instrument adopted by the Customs Co-operation Council (now the World Customs Organisation) in June 1983 and the International Convention on the Harmonised System (H.S. Convention) entered into force on the 1st January 1988

According to the H.S. Convention, the HS "means the Nomenclature comprising the headings and the subheadings and their related numerical codes, the Section, Chapter and Subheadings notes and the General Rules for the interpretation of the Harmonised System". The H.S. is designed as a "multipurpose nomenclature", to be used for transportable goods. Both H.S. and C.N. are therefore concerned heavily with the nature or material of the product.

The shape of the H.S. and the C.N. classifications is illustrated in the following table:

Country classification

The classification of countries is the country nomenclature (Geonomenclature) as set annually in the Official Journal of the European Communities. The full list of countries is given in an essentially geographical order in Table 4, Part A, Total trade statistics.

Partner country

For exports and dispatches, the trading partner is the country (or Member State) of final destination of the goods. The last country to which the goods are specifically directed on their outward movement from the State is regarded as their final destination. This is not necessarily the country in which the good will be unshipped or that in which they will be finally consumed.

For imports (extra-EU trade), the trading partner is the country of origin. In general, goods obtained entirely from a given country originate in that country. A product, in the production of which two or more countries were concerned, is considered as originating in the country in which the last transformation or substantial processing took place. Packing repacking, sorting and blending are not regarded as manufacturing processes.

For arrivals (intra-EU trade), the trading partner is the Member State of consignment of the goods.

Trade systems

There are broadly two approaches, closely linked with customs procedures, used for the measurement of international trade in goods: the general trade system and the special trade system.

General trade system

The general trade system is the wider concept and under it the recorded aggregates include all goods entering or leaving the economic territory of Cyprus with the exception of simple transit trade. In particular all goods which are received into customs warehouses are recorded as imports at that stage whether or not they subsequently go into free circulation in Cyprus. Similarly, outgoing goods from customs warehouses are included in the general trade aggregates at the time they leave Cyprus.

Special trade system

The special trade system is a narrower concept. Goods from a foreign country which are received into customs warehouse are not recorded in the special trade aggregates unless they subsequently go into free circulation in Cyprus (or are placed under the customs procedures for inward processing). Similarly, outgoing goods from customs warehouses are not recorded as exports.

Stores and provisions

Stores and provisions denote ships' and aircraft's stores and supplies.

- ships and aircraft's stores' means the various products for consumption by the crew and passengers of vessels or aircraft;
- ships and aircraft's supplies' means the products for the operation of the engines, machines and other equipment on vessels or aircraft, such as fuel, oil and lubricants.

Domestic and foreign goods

Domestic goods are goods originating in the economic territory of Cyprus; if they have been wholly obtained in it or were substantially transformed by processing in it, so that the processing confers domestic origin. Goods originally imported and having undergone only repair or minor operations which leave them essentially unchanged are not defined as domestic. Minor operations include blending, packaging, bottling, cleaning, sorting, husking and selling.

Foreign goods are goods originating in the rest of the world, i.e not included in the economic territory of Cyprus and compensating goods obtained under the outward processing procedure when such processing confers foreign origin.
