#### **PREFACE**

This report is issued on a monthly basis and aims at providing a general view of the external trade of Cyprus and its partner countries for February 2018. It is divided into three parts. Part A pertains to total trade statistics under the general trade system, Part B to Extra-EU trade statistics under the special trade system and Part C to Intra-EU trade statistics. All values shown in the tables of this report are in Euros.

The statistics of trade with non-EU countries (Extra-EU trade) are compiled mainly from 'THESEAS' system, the computerized system of Customs Authorities for imports and the customs exports computerized system. The statistics of trade with EU countries (Intra-EU trade) are compiled mainly via the Intrastat system and the data collected via the VAT returns.

This report was prepared by Mrs. E. Toumbaki, Assistant Clerical Officer and Mrs. I. Leontiou, Statistics Officer, under the guidance of Mr. S. Vikis, Statistics Officer A'.

#### INTRODUCTION

### **DEVELOPMENTS IN EXTERNAL TRADE FOR FEBRUARY 2018**

**Total imports/arrivals** (covering total imports from third countries and arrivals from E.U. countries) in January - February 2018 amounted to €1.224.8 mn as compared to €1.165,1 mn in January - February 2017.

**Total exports/dispatches** (covering total exports to third countries and dispatches to other E.U. Member States) in January - February 2018 were €390,8 mn compared to €353,1 mn in January - February 2017. As a result of the above developments the trade deficit was €834,0 mn in January - February 2018 compared to €812,0 mn in the corresponding period of 2017.

### Total imports/arrivals

Imported goods were €608,4 mn in February 2018 and €531,5 mn in February 2017.

#### a. Total imports/arrivals by H.S Section

For February 2018 Section V 'Mineral products' lead the list with  $\[ \in \]$ 146,5 mn, followed by Section XVII 'Vehicles, aircraft, vessels and associated transport equipment' with  $\[ \in \]$ 103,3 mn, Section XVI 'Machinery and mechanical appliances, electrical equipment and parts' with  $\[ \in \]$ 56,7 mn, Section IV 'Prepared foodstuffs, beverages, spirits and vinegar, tobacco and manufactured tobacco substitutes' with  $\[ \in \]$ 51,0 mn, Section VI 'Products of the chemical or allied industries' with  $\[ \in \]$ 47,2 mn, Section XV 'Base metals and articles of base metal' with  $\[ \in \]$ 46,1 mn, Section XI 'Textiles and textile articles' with  $\[ \in \]$ 25,7 mn and Section II 'Vegetable products' with  $\[ \in \]$ 21,3 mn.

#### b. Total imports/arrivals by economic destination

- Consumer goods valued at €162,7 mn or 26,8% in February 2018 and €144,3 mn or 27,1% in the respective month of 2017.
- Intermediate inputs valued at €136,6 mn or 22,5% in February 2018 as against €98,6 mn or 18,6% in February 2017. The manufacturing sector absorbed €84,5 mn in February 2018 as compared with €62,4 mn in February 2017. Raw materials for the construction sector were €25,9 mn in February 2018 and €14,7 mn in February 2017.
- Transport equipment with their parts accounted for €115,6 mn in February 2018 as compared with €147,8 mn in February 2017. Ships, boats and floating structures valued at €49,7 mn in February 2018 as compared with €93,2 mn in February 2017. Passenger motor vehicles were €39,8 mn in February 2018 and €35,4 mn in February 2017.
- Fuels and lubricants, including crude petroleum oil, valued at €145,2 mn in February 2018 and €110,8 mn in the corresponding month of 2017.
- Capital goods valued at €47,2 mn in February 2018 and €23,1 mn in February 2017. The manufacturing sector was €17,7 mn in February 2018 as against €3,3 mn in February 2017. Capital goods for the construction and mining sectors valued at €3,4 mn in February 2018 and €2,5 mn in February 2017. The transport, storage and communication sector valued at €4,5 mn in February 2018 and €4,0 mn in February 2017. Capital goods for agriculture accounted for €1,2 mn in February 2018 and €0,6 mn in the corresponding month of 2017.

#### c. Total imports/arrivals by area

- The European Union continued to be the main source of supply of goods to Cyprus in February 2018, with a share of €407,7 mn of total imports/arrivals. Major suppliers within the Union were Greece with €126,4 mn, Italy with €69,0 mn, Spain with €51,2 mn, the United Kingdom with €40,1 mn, Germany with €38,5 mn, the Netherlands with €22,8 mn, France with €13,7 mn and Belgium with €10,3 mn.
- Imports from all other European countries totaled €34,0 mn in February 2018 with Norway €11,8 mn, with Switzerland €7,4 mn and Ukraine with €5,1 mn.
- Imports from the rest of the world in February 2018 amounted to €166,7 mn with China €56,3 mn, Israel with €39,7 mn, United Arab Emirates with €5,3 mn, Argentina with €5,0 mn, Japan with €4,8 mn, India with €4,1 mn, United States with €3,2 mn, South Korea with €2,8 mn, Viet-Nam with €2,1 mn and Taiwan with €1,9 mn.

### d. Total imports/arrivals destined for home use

Imported goods destined for home use were €524,6 mn in February 2018 and €477,0 mn in February 2017.

#### Imports/arrivals destined for home use by economic destination

- Consumer goods valued at €153,1 mn or 29,2% and €134,97 mn or 28,3% in February 2018 and February 2017, accordingly.
- Intermediate inputs valued at €130,6 mn or 24,9% in February 2018 as against €93,8 mn or 19,7% in February 2017. The manufacturing sector absorbed €80,9 mn in February 2018 and €58,7 mn in February 2017.
- Transport equipment with their parts accounted for €107,7 mn in February 2018 as compared with €138,5 mn in February 2017. Ships, boats and floating structures valued at €49,7 mn in February 2018 as compared with €93,2 mn in February 2017. Passenger motor vehicles were €38,1 mn in February 2018 and €32,5 mn in February 2017.
- Fuels and lubricants, including crude petroleum oil, valued at €101,9 mn in February 2018 and €80,7 mn in the corresponding month of 2017.
- Capital goods valued at €30,1 mn in February 2018 and €22,2 mn in February 2017. The manufacturing sector was €4,9 mn in February 2018 as against €3,2 mn in February 2017. Capital goods for the construction and mining sectors valued at €3,1 mn in February 2018 and €2,3 mn in February 2017. The transport, storage and communication sector absorbed €4,3 mn in February 2018 as against €3,8 mn in February 2017. Capital goods for agriculture accounted for €1,3 mn in February 2018 and €0,6 mn the respective month of 2017.

### Total exports/dispatches

Total exports/dispatches, including stores and provisions, accounted for €187,3 mn in February 2018 as compared with €172,5 mn in February 2017.

#### a. Total exports/dispatches, including stores and provisions, by H.S Section

For February 2018 Section V 'Mineral products' lead the list with  $\epsilon$ 63,4 mn followed by Section VI 'Products of the chemical or allied industries' with  $\epsilon$ 28,2 mn, Section XVI 'Machinery electrical equipment and parts' with  $\epsilon$ 23,9 mn, Section I 'Live animals, animal products' with  $\epsilon$ 17,5 mn, Section IV 'Prepared foodstuffs, beverages, spirits and vinegar, tobacco and manufactured tobacco substitutes' with  $\epsilon$ 12,1 mn, Section XV 'Base metals and articles of base metal' with  $\epsilon$ 12,0 mn, Section II 'Vegetable products' with  $\epsilon$ 8,1 mn, Section XVIII 'Vehicles, aircraft, vessels and associated transport equipment' with  $\epsilon$ 5,7 mn and Section XVIII 'Optical, photographic, cinematographic, measuring, checking precision, medical or surgical instruments and apparatus;' with  $\epsilon$ 3,6 mn.

### Total exports/dispatches of domestically produced goods, excluding stores and provisions, by category

- Industrial products of domestic produce exported during February 2018 valued at €77,4 mn or 87,6% and €73,9 mn or 85,9% in February 2017.
- Exports/dispatches of raw agricultural products valued at €10,3 mn or 11,7% in February 2018 and €10,5 mn or 12,3% in the corresponding month of 2017.
- Mineral exports valued at €0,4 mn or 0,4% in February 2018 and €0,2 mn or 0,2% in February 2017.

#### c. Total exports/dispatches by area

- Dispatches to the European Union accounted for €69,2 mm in February 2018 of the total exports/dispatches. Dispatches to Greece accounted for €24,0 mm, to the United Kingdom for €10,1 mm, to the Netherlands for €8,9 mm, to Germany for €3,4 mm, to Italy and Sweden for €2,9 mm, to Slovakia for €2,6 mm, to Austria for €2,0 mm and to France for €1,6 mm.
- Exports to Near and Middle Eastern countries occupied the second place in importance with €23,8 mn in February 2018.
- Exports to all other European countries amounted to €22,0 mn in February 2018.
- Exports to North Africa occupied the second place in importance with €21,3 mn in February 2018.
- Exports to Other Asian countries with €10,5 mn in February 2018.
- Exports to North America countries amounted to €2,7 mn in February 2018.
- Exports for stores and provisions in February 2018 valued at €13,9 mn, to high seas in February 2018 valued at €13,5 mn and exports to countries and territories not specified in February 2018 amounted to €3,5 mn.







#### **DEFINITIONS OF TERMS USED**

## Arrivals

"Arrivals" are analogous to imports.

Arrivals include:

- a) goods in free circulation which enter the statistical territory of Cyprus;
- b) goods which have been placed under the CUSTOMS procedure for inward processing or processing under CUSTOMS control (for processing, transformation) in another Member State and which enter the statistical territory of Cyprus.
- c) Some goods movements are included in statistics based on specific conditions e.g. aircrafts and ships whose ownership has been transferred from a person established in another Member State to a person established in the Cyprus are included in the statistics of arrivals of Cyprus.

#### **Dispatches**

"Dispatches" are analogous to exports.

Dispatches include:

- a) goods in free circulation which leave the statistical territory of Cyprus bound for another Member State;
- b) goods which have been placed under the CUSTOMS procedure for inward processing or processing under CUSTOMS control (for processing, transformation) in Cyprus and which are destined for another Member State.
- c) Some goods movements are included in statistics based on specific conditions. In particular, aircraft and ships whose ownership has been transferred from a person established in the Cyprus to a person established in another Member State are included in the statistics on dispatches of Cyprus.

#### **Imports**

Imports under special trade system include:

- a) Goods, which enter the statistical territory of Cyprus from a non-member country and are:
  - Placed under the CUSTOMS procedure for release into free circulation (goods intended to be consumed in Cyprus or dispatched to another Member State), either immediately or after a period in a CUSTOMS warehouse or
  - Placed under the CUSTOMS procedure for inward processing or processing under CUSTOMS control (usually goods destined to be processed, transformed for subsequent re-export) either immediately or after a period in a CUSTOMS warehouse.
- b) Some movements of goods are included in statistics based on specific conditions e.g aircrafts and ships whose ownership has been transferred from a person established in a non-member country to a person established in Cyprus are included in import statistics of Cyprus.

#### **Exports**

Exports under special trade system include:

- a) goods that leave the statistical territory of Cyprus bound for a non-member country, having gone through:
  - The CUSTOMS export procedure (final export, export following inward processing, etc.); or
  - The CUSTOMS outwardprocessing procedure (usually goods destined to be processed, transformed for subsequent re-import).

# The Harmonized Commodity Description and Coding System (HS)

The Harmonised System is a legal instrument adopted by the Customs Co-operation Council (now the World Customs Organisation) in June 1983 and the International Convention on the Harmonised System (H.S. Convention) entered into force on the 1<sup>st</sup> January 1988

According to the H.S. Convention, the HS "means the Nomenclature comprising the headings and the subheadings and their related numerical codes, the Section, Chapter and Subheadings notes and the General Rules for the interpretation of the Harmonised System". The H.S. is designed as a "multipurpose nomenclature", to be used for transportable goods. Both H.S. and C.N. are therefore concerned heavily with the nature or material of the product.

# The shape of the H.S. and the C.N. classifications is illustrated in the following table:

## **Country classification**

The classification of countries is the country nomenclature (Geonomenclature) as set annually in the Official Journal of the European Communities. The full list of countries is given in an essentially geographical order in Table 4, Part A, Total trade statistics.

## Partner country

For exports and dispatches, the trading partner is the country (or Member State) of final destination of the goods. The last country to which the goods are specifically directed on their outward movement from the State is regarded as their final destination. This is not necessarily the country in which the good will be unshipped or that in which they will be finally consumed.

For imports (extra-EU trade), the trading partner is the country of origin. In general, goods obtained entirely from a given country originate in that country. A product, in the production of which two or more countries were concerned, is considered as originating in the country in which the last transformation or substantial processing took place. Packing repacking, sorting and blending are not regarded as manufacturing processes.

For arrivals (intra-EU trade), the trading partner is the Member State of consignment of the goods.

#### Trade systems

There are broadly two approaches, closely linked with customs procedures, used for the measurement of international trade in goods: the general trade system and the special trade system.

# General trade system

The general trade system is the wider concept and under it the recorded aggregates include all goods entering or leaving the economic territory of Cyprus with the exception of simple transit trade. In particular all goods which are received into customs warehouses are recorded as imports at that stage whether or not they subsequently go into free circulation in Cyprus. Similarly, outgoing goods from customs warehouses are included in the general trade aggregates at the time they leave Cyprus.

#### Special trade system

The special trade system is a narrower concept. Goods from a foreign country which are received into customs warehouse are not recorded in the special trade aggregates unless they subsequently go into free circulation in Cyprus (or are placed under the customs procedures for inward processing). Similarly, outgoing goods from customs warehouses are not recorded as exports.

### Stores and provisions

Stores and provisions denote ships' and aircraft's stores and supplies.

- ships and aircraft's stores' means the various products for consumption by the crew and passengers of vessels or aircraft;
- ships and aircraft's supplies' means the products for the operation of the engines, machines and other equipment on vessels or aircraft, such as fuel, oil and lubricants.

# Domestic and foreign goods

Domestic goods are goods originating in the economic territory of Cyprus; if they have been wholly obtained in it or were substantially transformed by processing in it, so that the processing confers domestic origin. Goods originally imported and having undergone only repair or minor operations which leave them essentially unchanged are not defined as domestic. Minor operations include blending, packaging, bottling, cleaning, sorting, husking and selling.

Foreign goods are goods originating in the rest of the world, i.e not included in the economic territory of Cyprus and compensating goods obtained under the outward processing procedure when such processing confers foreign origin.
