PREFACE

This report is issued on a monthly basis and aims at providing a general view of the external trade of Cyprus and its partner countries for January 2017. It is divided into three parts. Part A pertains to total trade statistics under the general trade system, Part B to Extra-EU trade statistics under the special trade system and Part C to Intra-EU trade statistics. All values shown in the tables of this report are in Euros.

The statistics of trade with non-EU countries (Extra-EU trade) are compiled mainly from 'THESEAS' system, the computerized system of Customs Authorities for imports and the customs exports computerized system. The statistics of trade with EU countries (Intra-EU trade) are compiled mainly via the Intrastat system and the data collected via the VAT returns.

This report was prepared by Mrs. I. Leontiou, Statistics Officer, under the guidance of Mr. S. Vikis, Statistics Officer A' and under the general supervision of Mr. S. Karagiorgis, Senior Statistics Officer, Head of Foreign Trade Division.

INTRODUCTION

DEVELOPMENTS IN EXTERNAL TRADE FOR JANUARY 2017

Total imports/arrivals (covering total imports from third countries and arrivals from E.U countries) in January 2017 amounted to €515,3mn as compared to €330,9mn in January 2016. **Total exports/dispatches** (covering total exports to third countries and dispatches to other Member States) in January 2017 were €165,5mn compared to €110,0mn in January 2016. As a result of the above developments the trade deficit was €349,7mn in January 2017 compared to €220,9mn in the corresponding month of 2016.

Total imports/arrivals

Imported goods were €515,3mn in January 2017 and €330,9mn in January 2016.

a. Total imports/arrivals by H.S Section

Section V ‘Mineral products ‘ lead the list with €142,2mn followed by Section XVII ‘Vehicles, aircraft, vessels and associated transport equipment’ with €96,1mn, Section XVI ‘Machinery, electrical equipment and parts’ with €57,3mn, Section IV ‘Prepared foodstuffs, beverages, spirits and vinegar, tobacco and manufactured tobacco substitutes’ with €44,3mn, Section VI ‘Products of the chemical or allied industries’ with €41,9mn, Section XV ‘Base metal and articles thereof’ with €19,6mn, Section XI ‘Textiles and textile articles’ with €18,1mn, and finally Section II ‘Vegetable products’ with €18,0mn.

Total imports/arrivals by economic destination

- Consumer goods valued at €132,6mn or 25,7% in January 2017 and €126,3mn or 38,2% in the respective month of 2016.
- Intermediate inputs valued at €101,9mn or 19,8% in January 2017 as against €80,9mn or 24,5% in January 2016. The manufacturing sector absorbed €60,5mn in January 2017 as compared with €51,2mn in January 2016. Raw materials for the construction sector were €18,2mn in January 2017 and €10,7mn in January 2016.
- Fuels and lubricants, including crude petroleum oil, valued at €141,6mn in January 2017 and €64,2mn in the corresponding month of 2016.
- Transport equipment with their parts accounted for €110,3mn in January 2017 as compared with €36,3mn in January 2016.
- Capital goods valued at €27,5mn in January 2017 and €20,8mn in January 2016. The manufacturing sector was €5,4mn in January 2017 as against €4,0mn in January 2016. Capital goods for the construction and mining sectors valued at €2,7mn in January 2017 and €1,8mn in January 2016. The transport, storage and communication sector valued at €5,2mn in the January 2017 and €3,5mn in January 2016. Capital goods for agriculture accounted for €0,6mn in January 2017 and €0,9mn in the corresponding month of 2016.

b. Total imports/arrivals by area

- The European Union continued to be the main source of supply of goods to Cyprus in January 2017, with a share of €297,3mn of total imports/arrivals. Major suppliers within the Union were Greece with €100,1mn, France with €37,4mn, the United Kingdom with €32,2mn, Germany with €30,9mn, Italy with €29,0mn, the Netherlands with €17,9mn, Spain with €13,3mn and Belgium with €9,0mn.

- Imports from all other European countries totaled €69,7mn in January 2017 with Russia €59,5mn, Moldova with €3,2mn and Switzerland with €3,0mn.
- Imports from the rest of the world in January 2017 amounted to €148,3mn with Israel €34,6mn, China(People's Republic of) with €19,9mn, Japan with €5,7mn, India with €5,1mn, Cuba with €4,5mn, the United States with €4,3mn, Viet-Nam with €3,7mn and Brazil with €3,3mn.

Total imports/arrivals destined for home use

Imported goods destined for home use were €435,6mn in January 2017 and €300,6mn in January 2016.

a. Imports/arrivals destined for home use by economic destination

- Consumer goods valued at €118,3mn or 27,2% and €114,7mn or 38,2% in January 2017 and January 2016, accordingly.
- Intermediate inputs valued at €98,4mn or 22,6% in January 2017 as against €77,9mn or 25,9% in January 2016. The manufacturing sector absorbed €57,8mn in January 2017 and €48,6mn in January 2016.
- Fuels and lubricants, including crude petroleum oil, valued at €95,1mn in January 2017 and €53,3mn in the corresponding month of 2016.
- Transport equipment with their parts accounted for €97,0mn in January 2017 as compared with €32,9mn in January 2016.
- Capital goods valued at €25,3mn in January 2017 and €19,5mn in January 2016. The manufacturing sector was €5,2mn in January 2017 as against €3,6mn in January 2016. Capital goods for the construction and mining sectors valued at €2,0mn in January 2017 and €1,8mn in January 2016. The transport, storage and communication sector absorbed €4,8mn in January 2017 as against €3,2mn in January 2016. Capital goods for agriculture accounted for €0,6mn in January 2017 and €0,8mn the respective month of 2016.

Total exports/dispatches

Total exports/dispatches, including stores and provisions, accounted for €165,5mn in January 2017 as compared with €110,0mn in January 2016.

a. Total exports/dispatches, including stores and provisions, by H.S Section

Section V 'Mineral products' lead the list with €56,3mn followed by Section XVI 'Machinery electrical equipment and parts' with €32,3mn, Section VI 'Products of the chemical or allied industries' with €19,9mn, Section I 'Live animals, animal products' with €15,1mn, Section XIV 'Natural or cultured pearls, precious or semi-precious stones and metals, jewellery, coins, e.t.c' with €13,7mn, Section IV 'Prepared foodstuffs, beverages, spirits and vinegar, tobacco and manufactured tobacco substitutes' with €9,1mn, Section II 'Vegetable products' with €4,6mn and Section XVIII 'Optical, photographic, cinematographic instruments, medical or surgical instruments, clock, watches, musical instruments, e.t.c' with €4,2mn.

b. Total exports/dispatches of domestically produced goods, excluding stores and provisions, by category

- Industrial products of domestic produce exported during January 2017 valued at €89,5mn and €52,5mn in January 2016.
- Exports/dispatches of raw agricultural products valued at €6,8mn or 7,1% in January 2017 and €7,2mn or 11,9% in the corresponding month of 2016.
- Mineral exports valued at €0,4mn or 0,4% in January 2017 and €0,4mn or 0,7% in January 2016.

c. Total exports/dispatches by area

- Dispatches to the European Union accounted for €47,7mn in January 2017 of the total exports/dispatches. Dispatches to Greece for €15,8mn, to the United Kingdom for €11,0mn, to Germany for €3,8mn, to Slovakia and Sweden for €2,2mn, to Czech Republic for €1,8mn, to Italy for €1,5mn, to the Netherlands for €1,4mn and to Austria for €1,2mn.
- Exports to Near and Middle Eastern countries occupied the second place in importance with €34,9mn for January 2017.
- Exports to the Asian countries in January 2017 amounted to €7,7mn.
- Exports to all other European countries in January 2017 followed in importance with €4,5mn.
- Exports to countries and territories not specified in January 2017 amounted to €9,0mn and stores and provisions in January 2017 valued at €16,6mn.

APPENDIX

DEFINITIONS OF TERMS USED

Arrivals

"Arrivals" are analogous to imports.

Arrivals include:

- a) goods in free circulation which enter the statistical territory of Cyprus;
- b) goods which have been placed under the CUSTOMS procedure for inward processing or processing under CUSTOMS control (for processing, transformation) in another Member State and which enter the statistical territory of Cyprus.
- c) Some goods movements are included in statistics based on specific conditions e.g. aircrafts and ships whose ownership has been transferred from a person established in another Member State to a person established in the Cyprus are included in the statistics of arrivals of Cyprus.

Dispatches

"Dispatches" are analogous to exports.

Dispatches include:

- a) goods in free circulation which leave the statistical territory of Cyprus bound for another Member State;
- b) goods which have been placed under the CUSTOMS procedure for inward processing or processing under CUSTOMS control (for processing, transformation) in Cyprus and which are destined for another Member State.
- c) Some goods movements are included in statistics based on specific conditions. In particular, aircraft and ships whose ownership has been transferred from a person established in the Cyprus to a person established in another Member State are included in the statistics on dispatches of Cyprus.

Imports

Imports **under special trade system** include:

- a) Goods, which enter the statistical territory of Cyprus from a non-member country and are:
 - Placed under the CUSTOMS procedure for release into free circulation (goods intended to be consumed in Cyprus or dispatched to another Member State), either immediately or after a period in a CUSTOMS warehouse or
 - Placed under the CUSTOMS procedure for inward processing or processing under CUSTOMS control (usually goods destined to be processed, transformed for subsequent re-export) either immediately or after a period in a CUSTOMS warehouse.

b) Some movements of goods are included in statistics based on specific conditions e.g. aircrafts and ships whose ownership has been transferred from a person established in a non-member country to a person established in Cyprus are included in import statistics of Cyprus.

Exports

Exports **under special trade system** include:

- a) goods that leave the statistical territory of Cyprus bound for a non-member country, having gone through:
 - The CUSTOMS export procedure (final export, export following inward processing, etc.); or
 - The CUSTOMS outward-processing procedure (usually goods destined to be processed, transformed for subsequent re-import).

The Harmonized Commodity Description and Coding System (HS) Partner country

The Harmonised System is a legal instrument adopted by the Customs Co-operation Council (now the World Customs Organisation) in June 1983 and the International Convention on the Harmonised System (H.S. Convention) entered into force on the 1st January 1988.

According to the H.S. Convention, the HS "means the Nomenclature comprising the headings and the subheadings and their related numerical codes, the Section, Chapter and Subheadings notes and the General Rules for the interpretation of the Harmonised System". The H.S. is designed as a "multipurpose nomenclature", to be used for transportable goods. Both H.S. and C.N. are therefore concerned heavily with the nature or material of the product.

For exports and dispatches, the trading partner is the country (or Member State) of final destination of the goods. The last country to which the goods are specifically directed on their outward movement from the State is regarded as their final destination. This is not necessarily the country in which the good will be unshipped or that in which they will be finally consumed.

For imports (extra-EU trade), the trading partner is the country of origin. In general, goods obtained entirely from a given country originate in that country. A product, in the production of which two or more countries were concerned, is considered as originating in the country in which the last transformation or substantial processing took place. Packing repacking, sorting and blending are not regarded as manufacturing processes.

The shape of the H.S. and the C.N. classifications is illustrated in the following table:

For arrivals (intra-EU trade), the trading partner is the Member State of consignment of the goods.

Trade systems

There are broadly two approaches, closely linked with customs procedures, used for the measurement of international trade in goods: the general trade system and the special trade system.

General trade system

The general trade system is the wider concept and under it the recorded aggregates include all goods entering or leaving the economic territory of Cyprus with the exception of simple transit trade. In particular all goods which are received into customs warehouses are recorded as imports at that stage whether or not they subsequently go into free circulation in Cyprus. Similarly, outgoing goods from customs warehouses are included in the general trade aggregates at the time they leave Cyprus.

Country classification

The classification of countries is the country nomenclature (Geonomenclature) as set annually in the Official Journal of the European Communities. The full list of countries is given in an essentially geographical order in Table 4, Part A, Total trade statistics.

Special trade system

The special trade system is a narrower concept. Goods from a foreign country which are received into customs warehouse are not recorded in the special trade aggregates unless they subsequently go into free circulation in Cyprus (or are placed under the customs procedures for inward processing). Similarly, outgoing goods from customs warehouses are not recorded as exports.

Stores and provisions

Stores and provisions denote ships' and aircraft's stores and supplies.

- ships and aircraft's stores' means the various products for consumption by the crew and passengers of vessels or aircraft;

- ships and aircraft's supplies' means the products for the operation of the engines, machines and other equipment on vessels or aircraft, such as fuel, oil and lubricants.

Domestic and foreign goods

Domestic goods are goods originating in the economic territory of Cyprus; if they have been wholly obtained in it or were substantially transformed by processing in it, so that the processing confers domestic origin. Goods originally imported and having undergone only repair or minor operations which leave them essentially unchanged are not defined as domestic. Minor operations include blending, packaging, bottling, cleaning, sorting, husking and selling.

Foreign goods are goods originating in the rest of the world, i.e not included in the economic territory of Cyprus and compensating goods obtained under the outward processing procedure when such processing confers foreign origin.
