PREFACE

This report is issued on a monthly basis and aims at providing a general view of the external trade of Cyprus and its partner countries for March 2019. It is divided into three parts. Part A pertains to total trade statistics under the general trade system, Part B to Extra-EU trade statistics under the special trade system and Part C to Intra-EU trade statistics. All values shown in the tables of this report are in Euros.

The statistics of trade with non-EU countries (Extra-EU trade) are compiled mainly from 'THESEAS' system, the computerized system of Customs Authorities for imports and the customs computerized system for exports. The statistics of trade with EU countries (Intra-EU trade) are compiled mainly via the Intrastat system and the data collected via the VAT returns.

This report was prepared by Mrs. I. Leontiou, Statistics Officer, under the guidance of Mr. S. Vikis, Statistics Officer A'.

INTRODUCTION

DEVELOPMENTS IN EXTERNAL TRADE FOR MARCH 2019

Total imports (covering total imports from third countries and arrivals from E.U. countries) in January-March 2019 amounted to €1.976,3 mn as compared to €1.963,9 mn in January-March 2018.

Total exports (covering total exports to third countries and dispatches to E.U. Member States) in January-March 2019 were €930,5 mn compared to €1.278,8 mn in January-March 2018. As a result of the above developments the trade deficit was €1.045,8 mn in January-March 2019 compared to €685,1 mn in the corresponding period of 2018.

Total imports in January-March 2019 include the transfer of economic ownership of mobile transport equipment (vessels), with total value of €384,5 mn as compared to €322,5 mn in January-March 2018. Total exports in January-March 2019 include the transfer of economic ownership of mobile transport equipment (vessels), with total value of €503,8 mn as compared to €682,9 mn in January-March 2018.

Total imports

Imported goods were €598,8 mn in March 2019 and €729,9 mn in March 2018.

a. Total imports by H.S Section

For March 2019 Section V ‘Mineral products’ lead the list with €98,4 mn followed by Section XVII ‘Vehicles, aircraft, vessels and associated transport equipment’ with €96,2 mn, Section XVI ‘Machinery and mechanical appliances, electrical equipment and parts’ with €72,2 mn, Section VI ‘Products of the chemical or allied industries’ with €64,4 mn, Section IV ‘Prepared foodstuffs, beverages, spirits and vinegar, tobacco and manufactured tobacco substitutes’ with €62,9 mn, Section XV ‘Base metals and articles of base metal’ with €39,0 mn, Section XI ‘Textiles and textile articles’ with €25,4 mn, Section XX ‘Miscellaneous manufactured articles’ with €21,0 mn, Section VII ‘Plastics and articles thereof’ with €20,9 mn and Section I ‘Live animals, animal products’ with €19,6 mn.

b. Total imports by economic destination

- Consumer goods valued at €193,3 mn or 32,3% in March 2019 and €180,1 mn or 24,7% in the respective month of 2018.
- Intermediate inputs valued at €150,1 mn or 25,1% in March 2019 as against €132,0 mn or 18,1% in March 2018. The manufacturing sector absorbed €89,7 mn in March 2019 as compared with €77,5 mn in March 2018. Raw materials for the construction sector were €30,0 mn in March 2019 and €29,4 mn in March 2018.
- Transport equipment with their parts accounted for €114,3 mn in March 2019 as compared with €272,8 mn in March 2018. Ships, boats and floating structures valued at €42,1 mn in March 2019 as compared with €203,1 mn in March 2018. Passenger motor vehicles were €42,3 mn in March 2019 and €37,8 mn in March 2018.
- Fuels and lubricants, including crude petroleum oil, valued at €97,9 mn in March 2019 and €86,8 mn in the corresponding month of 2018.
- Capital goods valued at €39,4 mn in March 2019 and €55,0 mn in March 2018. The manufacturing sector was €7,3 mn in March 2019 as against €24,9 mn in March 2018. Capital goods for the construction and mining sectors valued at €3,9 mn in March 2019 and €2,7 mn in March 2018. The transport, storage and communication sector valued at €6,6 mn in March 2019 and €6,0 mn in March 2018. Capital goods for agriculture accounted for €1,7 mn in March 2019 and €2,3 mn in the corresponding month of 2018.

c. Total imports by area

- The European Union continued to be the main source of supply of goods to Cyprus in March 2019, with a share of €442,7 mn of total imports. Major suppliers within the Union were Greece with €141,8 mn, the United Kingdom with €53,2 mn, Italy with €49,1 mn, France with €41,6 mn, Germany with €39,2 mn, the Netherlands with €38,7 mn, Spain with €23,3 mn and Belgium with €15,0 mn.
- Imports from all other European countries totaled €18,1 mn in March 2019 with Russia €6,4 mn, Switzerland with €4,7 mn and Ukraine with €2,7 mn.
- Imports from the rest of the world in March 2019 amounted to €137,9 mn with Israel €36,2 mn, China with €25,8 mn, Liberia with €19,8 mn, India with €7,5 mn, Argentina with €6,3 mn, Japan with €5,3 mn, the United States with €4,8 mn and Egypt with €3,1 mn.

d. Total imports destined for home use

Imported goods destined for home use were €546,5 mn in March 2019 and €654,2 mn in March 2018.

Imports destined for home use by economic destination

- Consumer goods valued at €182,6 mn or 33,4% and €172,0 mn or 26,3% in March 2019 and March 2018, accordingly.
- Intermediate inputs valued at €147,1 mn or 26,9% in March 2019 as against €129,6 mn or 19,8% in March 2018. The manufacturing sector absorbed €87,9 mn in March 2019 and €75,9 mn in March 2018.
- Transport equipment with their parts accounted for €102,8 mn in March 2019 as compared with €263,3 mn in March 2018. Ships, boats and floating structures valued at €42,1 mn in March 2019 as compared with €203,1 mn in March 2018. Passenger motor vehicles were €41,6 mn in March 2019 and €38,4 mn in March 2018.
- Fuels and lubricants, including crude petroleum oil, valued at €74,1 mn in March 2019 and €51,4 mn in the corresponding month of 2018.
- Capital goods valued at €36,1 mn in March 2019 and €34,6 mn in March 2018. The manufacturing sector was €6,9 mn in March 2019 as against €6,1 mn in March 2018. Capital goods for the construction and mining sectors valued at €3,3 mn in March 2019 and €2,3 mn in March 2018. The transport, storage and communication sector absorbed €5,7 mn in March 2019 as against €5,7 mn in March 2018. Capital goods for agriculture accounted for €1,7 mn in March 2019 and €2,3 mn the respective month of 2018.

Total exports

Total exports, including stores and provisions, accounted for €212,7 mn in March 2019 as compared with €882,9 mn in March 2018.

a. Total exports, including stores and provisions, by H.S Section

For March 2019 Section XVII ‘Vehicles, aircraft, vessels and associated transport equipment’ with €55,9 mn lead the list followed by Section V ‘Mineral products’ with €35,4 mn, Section VI ‘Products of the chemical or allied industries’ with €28,9 mn, Section XVI ‘Machinery electrical equipment and parts’ with €25,6 mn, Section I ‘Live animals, animal products’ with €22,7 mn, Section IV ‘Prepared foodstuffs, beverages, spirits and vinegar, tobacco and manufactured tobacco substitutes’ with €10,7 mn, Section II ‘Vegetable products’ with €8,1 mn and Section XV ‘Base metals and articles of base metal’ with €5,8 mn.

b. Total exports of domestically produced goods, excluding stores and provisions, by category

- Industrial products of domestic produce exported during March 2019 valued at €77,8 mn or 86,8% and €93,3 mn or 86,2% in March 2018.
- Exports of raw agricultural products valued at €10,2 mn or 11,3% in March 2019 and €13,2 mn or 12,2% in the corresponding month of 2018.
- Mineral exports valued at €0,4 mn or 0,4% in March 2019 and €0,6 mn or 0,5% in March 2018.

c. Total exports by area

- Exports to the European Union accounted for €90,4 mn in March 2019 of the total exports. Exports to Greece accounted for €19,1 mn, to Italy for €15,3 mn, to the United Kingdom for €14,1 mn, to Malta for €13,7 mn, to Germany for €5,6 mn, to Sweden for €4,0 mn, to the Netherlands for €2,0 mn, to France for €1,9 mn and to Austria and Romania for €1,7 mn.
- Exports to Asian countries accounted for €22,7 mn in March 2019, to North Africa for €15,4 mn, to Near and Middle Eastern countries for €15,1 mn, to countries of Oceania and Polar regions for €10,3 mn, to North America for €8,1 mn and to other European countries for €4,1 mn.
- Stores and provisions to ships and aircrafts in March 2019 valued at €25,6 mn, exports to high seas in March 2019 valued at €9,1 mn and exports to countries and territories not specified in March 2019 amounted to €3,8 mn.

APPENDIX

DEFINITIONS OF TERMS USED

Arrivals

"Arrivals" are analogous to imports.

Arrivals include:

- a) goods in free circulation which enter the statistical territory of Cyprus;
- b) goods which have been placed under the CUSTOMS procedure for inward processing or processing under CUSTOMS control (for processing, transformation) in another Member State and which enter the statistical territory of Cyprus.
- c) Some goods movements are included in statistics based on specific conditions e.g. aircrafts and ships whose ownership has been transferred from a person established in another Member State to a person established in the Cyprus are included in the statistics of arrivals of Cyprus.

Dispatches

"Dispatches" are analogous to exports.

Dispatches include:

- a) goods in free circulation which leave the statistical territory of Cyprus bound for another Member State;
- b) goods which have been placed under the CUSTOMS procedure for inward processing or processing under CUSTOMS control (for processing, transformation) in Cyprus and which are destined for another Member State.
- c) Some goods movements are included in statistics based on specific conditions. In particular, aircraft and ships whose ownership has been transferred from a person established in the Cyprus to a person established in another Member State are included in the statistics on dispatches of Cyprus.

Imports

Imports **under special trade system** include:

- a) Goods, which enter the statistical territory of Cyprus from a non-member country and are:

- Placed under the CUSTOMS procedure for release into free circulation (goods intended to be consumed in Cyprus or dispatched to another Member State), either immediately or after a period in a CUSTOMS warehouse or
- Placed under the CUSTOMS procedure for inward processing or processing under CUSTOMS control (usually goods destined to be processed, transformed for subsequent re-export) either immediately or after a period in a CUSTOMS warehouse.

- b) Some movements of goods are included in statistics based on specific conditions e.g aircrafts and ships whose ownership has been transferred from a person established in a non-member country to a person established in Cyprus are included in import statistics of Cyprus.

Exports

Exports **under special trade system** include:

- a) goods that leave the statistical territory of Cyprus bound for a non-member country, having gone through:

- The CUSTOMS export procedure (final export, export following inward processing, etc.); or
- The CUSTOMS outward-processing procedure (usually goods destined to be processed, transformed for subsequent re-import).

The Harmonized Commodity Description and Coding System (HS)

The Harmonised System is a legal instrument adopted by the Customs Co-operation Council (now the World Customs Organisation) in June 1983 and the International Convention on the Harmonised System (H.S. Convention) entered into force on the 1st January 1988.

According to the H.S. Convention, the HS "means the Nomenclature comprising the headings and the subheadings and their related numerical codes, the Section, Chapter and Subheadings notes and the General Rules for the interpretation of the Harmonised System". The H.S. is designed as a "multipurpose nomenclature", to be used for transportable goods. Both H.S. and C.N. are therefore concerned heavily with the nature or material of the product.

The shape of the H.S. and the C.N. classifications is illustrated in the following table:

Country classification

The classification of countries is the country nomenclature (Geonomenclature) as set annually in the Official Journal of the European Communities. The full list of countries is given in an essentially geographical order in Table 4, Part A, Total trade statistics.

Partner country

For exports and dispatches, the trading partner is the country (or Member State) of final destination of the goods. The last country to which the goods are specifically directed on their outward movement from the State is regarded as their final destination. This is not necessarily the country in which the good will be unshipped or that in which they will be finally consumed.

For imports (extra-EU trade), the trading partner is the country of origin. In general, goods obtained entirely from a given country originate in that country. A product, in the production of which two or more countries were concerned, is considered as originating in the country in which the last transformation or substantial processing took place. Packing repacking, sorting and blending are not regarded as manufacturing processes.

For arrivals (intra-EU trade), the trading partner is the Member State of consignment of the goods.

Trade systems

There are broadly two approaches, closely linked with customs procedures, used for the measurement of international trade in goods: the general trade system and the special trade system.

General trade system

The general trade system is the wider concept and under it the recorded aggregates include all goods entering or leaving the economic territory of Cyprus with the exception of simple transit trade. In particular all goods which are received into customs warehouses are recorded as imports at that stage whether or not they subsequently go into free circulation in Cyprus. Similarly, outgoing goods from customs warehouses are included in the general trade aggregates at the time they leave Cyprus.

Special trade system

The special trade system is a narrower concept. Goods from a foreign country which are received into customs warehouse are not recorded in the special trade aggregates unless they subsequently go into free circulation in Cyprus (or are placed under the customs procedures for inward processing). Similarly, outgoing goods from customs warehouses are not recorded as exports.

Stores and provisions

Stores and provisions denote ships' and aircraft's stores and supplies.

- ships and aircraft's stores' means the various products for consumption by the crew and passengers of vessels or aircraft;
- ships and aircraft's supplies' means the products for the operation of the engines, machines and other equipment on vessels or aircraft, such as fuel, oil and lubricants.

Domestic and foreign goods

Domestic goods are goods originating in the economic territory of Cyprus; if they have been wholly obtained in it or were substantially transformed by processing in it, so that the processing confers domestic origin. Goods originally imported and having undergone only repair or minor operations which leave them essentially unchanged are not defined as domestic. Minor operations include blending, packaging, bottling, cleaning, sorting, husking and selling.

Foreign goods are goods originating in the rest of the world, i.e not included in the economic territory of Cyprus and compensating goods obtained under the outward processing procedure when such processing confers foreign origin.
