## **PREFACE**

This report is issued on a monthly basis and aims at providing a general view of the external trade of Cyprus and its partner countries for September 2014. It is divided into three parts. Part A pertains to total trade statistics under the general trade system, Part B to Extra-EU trade statistics under the special trade system and Part C to Intra-EU trade statistics. All values shown in the tables of this report are in Euros.

The statistics of trade with non-EU countries (Extra-EU trade) are compiled mainly from THESEAS system, the computerised system of Customs Authorities for imports and the Single Administrative Document for exports. The statistics of trade with EU countries (Intra-EU trade) are compiled mainly via the INTRASTAT system and the data collected via the VAT returns.

The valuable cooperation of the Department of Customs and Excise and the VAT Service is acknowledged.

This report was prepared by the staff of the Foreign Trade Section, under the guidance of Mr. S. Vikis, Statistics Officer A' and the general supervision of Mr. George Sarris, Senior Statistics Officer, Head of Foreign Trade Section.

## INTRODUCTION

### DEVELOPMENTS IN EXTERNAL TRADE FOR SEPTEMBER 2014

**Total imports/arrivals** (covering total imports from third countries and arrivals from E.U countries) in January-September 2014 amounted to €3.895,4mn as compared to €3.584,0mn in January-September 2013. **Total exports/dispatches** (covering total exports to third countries and dispatches to other Member States) in January-September 2014 were €1.108,4mn compared to €1.209,3mn in January-September 2013. As a result of the above developments the trade deficit was €2.787,0mn in January-September 2014 compared to €2.374,6mn in the corresponding month of 2013.

#### Total imports/arrivals

Imported goods were €636,1mn in September 2014 and €443,1mn in September 2013.

#### **a. Total imports/arrivals by H.S Section**

Section XVII 'Vehicles, aircraft, vessels and associated transport equipment' lead the list with €205,1mn followed by Section V 'Mineral products' with €126,5mn, Section IV 'Prepared foodstuffs, beverages, spirits and vinegar, tobacco and manufactured tobacco substitutes' with €52,0mn, Section VI 'Products of the chemical or allied industries' with €50,5mn, Section XVI 'Machinery, electrical equipment and parts' with €41,2mn, Section XI 'Textiles and textile articles' with €29,7mn, Section II 'Vegetable Products' with €19,5mn and finally Section XV 'Base metal and articles of base metal' with €18,1mn.

#### **Total imports/arrivals by economic destination**

- Consumer goods valued at €167,8mn or 26,4% in September 2014 and €151,4mn or 34,2% in the respective month of 2013.
- Intermediate inputs valued at €98,7mn or 15,5% in September 2014 as against €98,1mn or 22,2% in September 2013. The manufacturing sector absorbed €62,9mn in September 2014 as compared with €66,8mn in September 2013. Raw materials for the construction sector were €12,0mn in September 2014 and €9,6mn in September 2013.
- Fuels and lubricants, including crude petroleum oil, valued at €125,9mn in September 2014 and €135,1mn in the corresponding month of 2013.
- Transport equipment with their parts accounted for €34,7mn in September 2014 as compared with €18,2mn in September 2013.
- Capital goods valued at €203,0mn in September 2014 and €40,1mn in September 2013. The manufacturing sector was €9,4mn in September 2014 as against €22,2mn in September 2013. Capital goods for the construction and mining sectors valued at €2,1mn in September 2014 and €2,2mn in September 2013. The transport, storage and communication sector valued at €179,9mn in the September 2014 and €4,2mn in September 2013. Capital goods for agriculture accounted for €0,8mn in September 2014 and €1,1mn in the corresponding month of 2013.

#### **b. Total imports/arrivals by area**

- The European Union continued to be the main source of supply of goods to Cyprus in September 2014, with a share of €333,7mn of total imports/arrivals. Major suppliers within the Union were Greece with €109,1mn, the Netherlands with €46,9mn, the United Kingdom with €33,9mn, Germany with €30,9mn, Italy with €30,8mn, France with €28,1mn and Spain with €18,5mn.

- Imports from all other European countries totaled €11,6mn in September 2014 with Switzerland €3,4mn and Ukraine with €1,9mn.
- Imports from the rest of the world in September 2014 amounted to €290,8mn with Cayman Islands €173,8mn, Israel with €49,0mn, China (People's Republic of) with €21,3mn, Canada with €6,0mn, the United States with €5,0mn, India with €4,4mn and Japan with €3,1mn.

### **Total imports/arrivals destined for home use**

Imported goods destined for home use were €613,8mn in September 2014 and €408,6mn in September 2013.

#### **a. Imports/arrivals destined for home use by economic destination**

- Consumer goods valued at €159,9mn or 26,1% and €145,5mn or 35,6% in September 2014 and September 2013, accordingly.
- Intermediate inputs valued at €95,5mn or 15,6% in September 2014 as against €96,8mn or 23,7% in September 2013. The manufacturing sector absorbed €60,7mn in September 2014 and €65,9mn in September 2013.
- Fuels and lubricants, including crude petroleum oil, valued at €116,3mn in September 2014 and €124,9mn in the corresponding month of 2013.
- Transport equipment with their parts accounted for €34,5mn in September 2014 as compared with €17,7mn in September 2013.
- Capital goods valued at €201,4mn in September 2014 and €23,5mn in September 2013. The manufacturing sector was €8,9mn in September 2014 as against €6,0mn in September 2013. Capital goods for the construction and mining sectors valued at €2,3mn in September 2014 and €2,2mn in September 2013. The transport, storage and communication sector absorbed €179,8mn in September 2014 as against €3,9mn in September 2013. Capital goods for agriculture accounted for €0,8mn in September 2014 and €1,0mn the respective month of 2013.

### **Total exports/dispatches**

Total exports/dispatches, including stores and provisions, accounted for €112,7mn in September 2014 as compared with €146,5mn in September 2013.

#### **a. Total exports/dispatches, including stores and provisions, by H.S Section**

Section V 'Mineral products' lead the list with €31,1mn followed by Section VI 'Products of the chemical or allied industries' with €27,2mn, Section XVI 'Machinery electrical equipment and parts' with €10,8mn, Section IV 'Prepared foodstuffs, beverages, spirits and vinegar, tobacco and manufactured tobacco substitutes' with €9,9mn, Section I 'Live animals, animal products' with €9,4mn and Section XV 'Base metal and articles of base metal' with €5,1mn.

#### **b. Total exports/dispatches of domestically produced goods, excluding stores and provisions, by category**

- Industrial products of domestic produce exported during September 2014 valued at €51,1mn and €45,1mn in September 2013.
- Exports/dispatches of raw agricultural products valued at €3,5mn or 6,3% in September 2014 and €3,7mn or 7,4% in the corresponding month of 2013.

- Mineral exports valued at €0,4mn or 0,7% in September 2014 and €0,4mn or 0,9% in September 2013.

**c. Total exports/dispatches by area**

- Dispatches to the European Union accounted for €42,5mn in September 2014 of the total exports/dispatches. Dispatches to Greece accounted for €15,1mn, to the United Kingdom for €9,9mn, to Slovakia for €3,0mn, to Germany for €2,6mn, to Italy for €2,0mn, to Sweden for €1,5mn and to the Netherlands for €1,4mn.
- Exports to Near and Middle Eastern countries occupied the second place in importance with €19,4mn for September 2014.
- Exports to the Asian countries in September 2014 amounted to €11,5mn.
- Exports to all other European countries in September 2014 followed in importance with €3,3mn.
- Exports to countries and territories not specified in September 2014 amounted to €0,2mn and stores and provisions in September 2014 valued at €25,8mn.

## DEFINITIONS OF TERMS USED

### Arrivals

"Arrivals" are analogous to imports.

Arrivals include:

- a) goods in free circulation which enter the statistical territory of Cyprus;
- b) goods which have been placed under the CUSTOMS procedure for inward processing or processing under CUSTOMS control (for processing, transformation) in another Member State and which enter the statistical territory of Cyprus.
- c) Some goods movements are included in statistics based on specific conditions e.g. aircrafts and ships whose ownership has been transferred from a person established in another Member State to a person established in the Cyprus are included in the statistics of arrivals of Cyprus.

### Dispatches

"Dispatches" are analogous to exports.

Dispatches include:

- a) goods in free circulation which leave the statistical territory of Cyprus bound for another Member State;
- b) goods which have been placed under the CUSTOMS procedure for inward processing or processing under CUSTOMS control (for processing, transformation) in Cyprus and which are destined for another Member State.
- c) Some goods movements are included in statistics based on specific conditions. In particular, aircraft and ships whose ownership has been transferred from a person established in the Cyprus to a person established in another Member State are included in the statistics on dispatches of Cyprus.

### Imports

Imports **under special trade system** include:

- a) Goods, which enter the statistical territory of Cyprus from a non-member country and are:
  - Placed under the CUSTOMS procedure for release into free circulation (goods intended to be consumed in Cyprus or dispatched to another Member State), either immediately or after a period in a CUSTOMS warehouse or
  - Placed under the CUSTOMS procedure for inward processing or processing under CUSTOMS control (usually goods destined to be processed, transformed for subsequent re-export) either immediately or after a period in a CUSTOMS warehouse.

b) Some movements of goods are included in statistics based on specific conditions e.g. aircrafts and ships whose ownership has been transferred from a person established in a non-member country to a person established in Cyprus are included in import statistics of Cyprus.

### Exports

Exports **under special trade system** include:

- a) goods that leave the statistical territory of Cyprus bound for a non-member country, having gone through:
  - The CUSTOMS export procedure (final export, export following inward processing, etc.); or
  - The CUSTOMS outward-processing procedure (usually goods destined to be processed, transformed for subsequent re-import).

### **The Harmonized Commodity Description and Coding System (HS)**

The Harmonised System is a legal instrument adopted by the Customs Co-operation Council (now the World Customs Organisation) in June 1983 and the International Convention on the Harmonised System (H.S. Convention) entered into force on the 1<sup>st</sup> January 1988.

According to the H.S. Convention, the HS "means the Nomenclature comprising the headings and the subheadings and their related numerical codes, the Section, Chapter and Subheadings notes and the General Rules for the interpretation of the Harmonised System". The H.S. is designed as a "multipurpose nomenclature", to be used for transportable goods. Both H.S. and C.N. are therefore concerned heavily with the nature or material of the product.

**The shape of the H.S. and the C.N. classifications is illustrated in the following table:**

### **Country classification**

The classification of countries is the country nomenclature (Geonomenclature) as set annually in the Official Journal of the European Communities. The full list of countries is given in an essentially geographical order in Table 4, Part A, Total trade statistics.

### **Partner country**

For exports and dispatches, the trading partner is the country (or Member State) of final destination of the goods. The last country to which the goods are specifically directed on their outward movement from the State is regarded as their final destination. This is not necessarily the country in which the good will be unshipped or that in which they will be finally consumed.

For imports (extra-EU trade), the trading partner is the country of origin. In general, goods obtained entirely from a given country originate in that country. A product, in the production of which two or more countries were concerned, is considered as originating in the country in which the last transformation or substantial processing took place. Packing repacking, sorting and blending are not regarded as manufacturing processes.

For arrivals (intra-EU trade), the trading partner is the Member State of consignment of the goods.

### **Trade systems**

There are broadly two approaches, closely linked with customs procedures, used for the measurement of international trade in goods: the general trade system and the special trade system.

### **General trade system**

The general trade system is the wider concept and under it the recorded aggregates include all goods entering or leaving the economic territory of Cyprus with the exception of simple transit trade. In particular all goods which are received into customs warehouses are recorded as imports at that stage whether or not they subsequently go into free circulation in Cyprus. Similarly, outgoing goods from customs warehouses are included in the general trade aggregates at the time they leave Cyprus.

### **Special trade system**

The special trade system is a narrower concept. Goods from a foreign country which are received into customs warehouse are not recorded in the special trade aggregates unless they subsequently go into free circulation in Cyprus (or are placed under the customs procedures for inward processing). Similarly, outgoing goods from customs warehouses are not recorded as exports.

### **Stores and provisions**

Stores and provisions denote ships' and aircraft's stores and supplies.

- ships and aircraft's stores' means the various products for consumption by the crew and passengers of vessels or aircraft;

- ships and aircraft's supplies' means the products for the operation of the engines, machines and other equipment on vessels or aircraft, such as fuel, oil and lubricants.

### **Domestic and foreign goods**

Domestic goods are goods originating in the economic territory of Cyprus; if they have been wholly obtained in it or were substantially transformed by processing in it, so that the processing confers domestic origin. Goods originally imported and having undergone only repair or minor operations which leave them essentially unchanged are not defined as domestic. Minor operations include blending, packaging, bottling, cleaning, sorting, husking and selling.

Foreign goods are goods originating in the rest of the world, i.e not included in the economic territory of Cyprus and compensating goods obtained under the outward processing procedure when such processing confers foreign origin.
