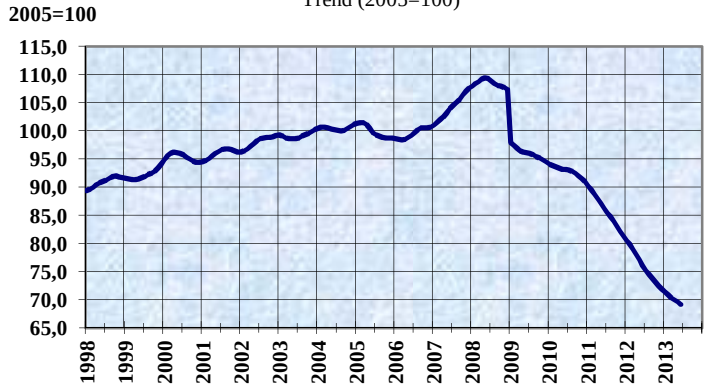


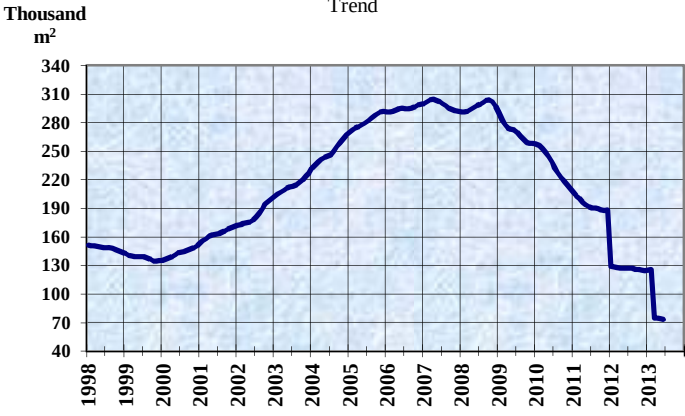

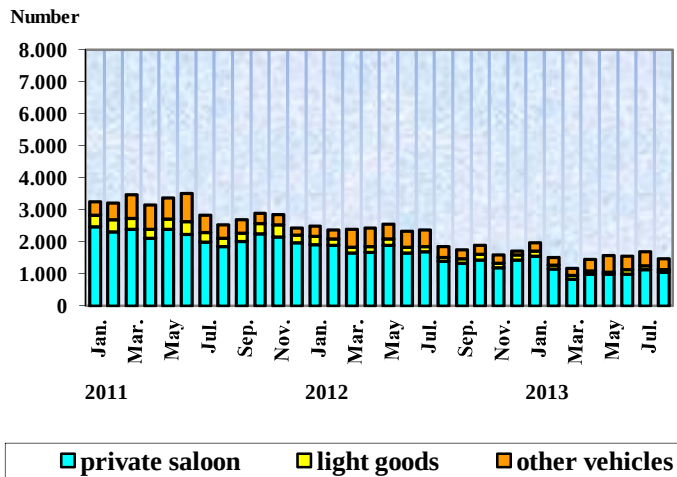
VOLUME INDEX OF

Trend



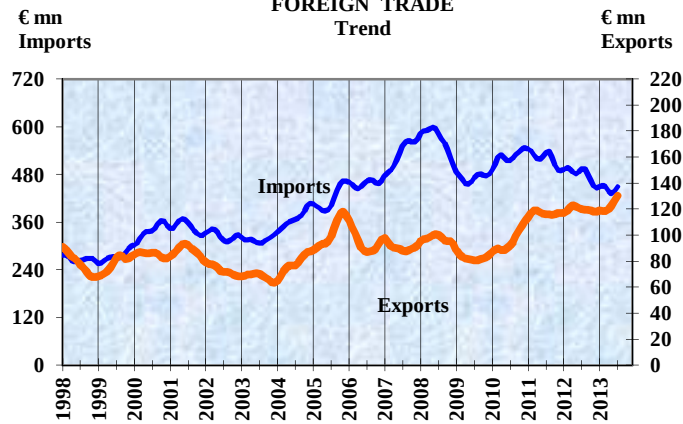
REGISTRATIONS OF MOTOR VEHICLES
