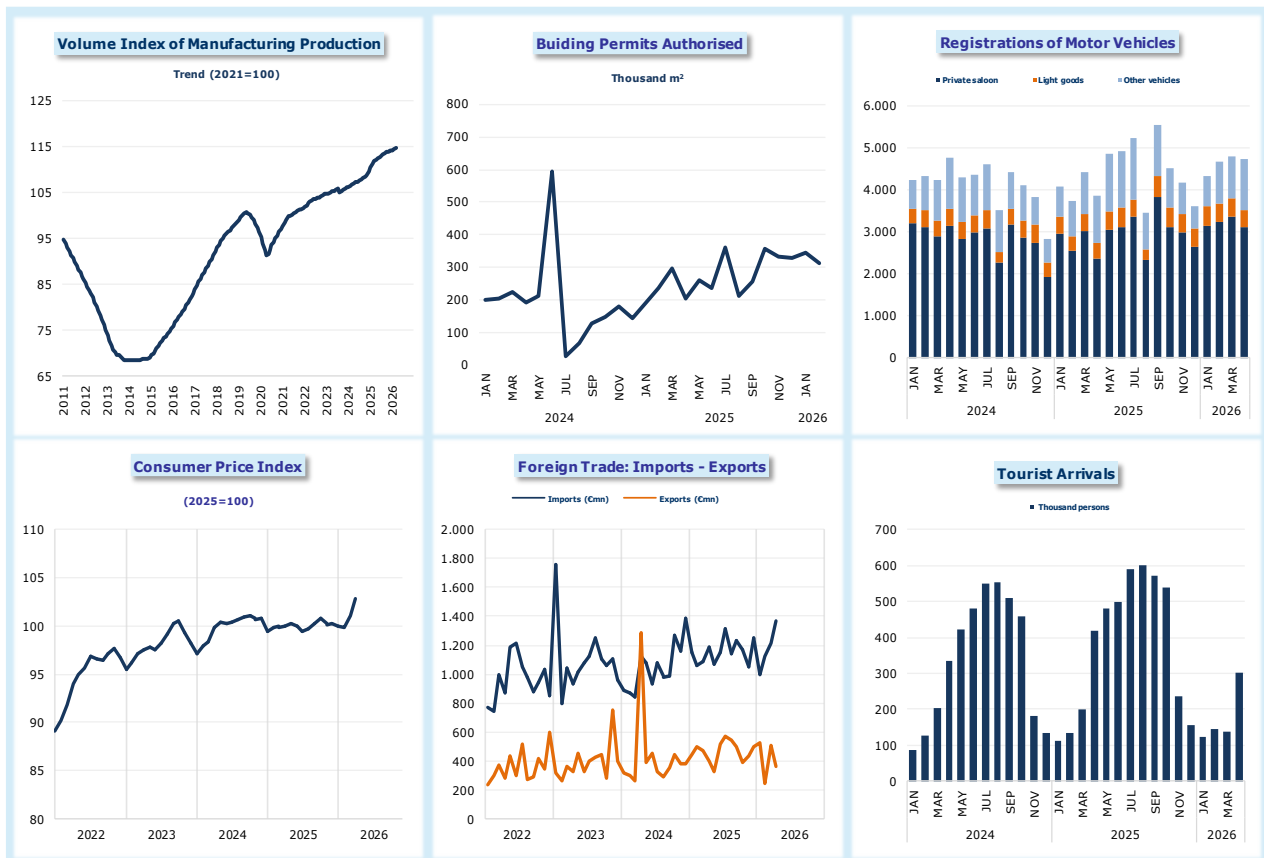

## PRESS RELEASE

### MONTHLY ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENTS: JANUARY-APRIL 2026

The Statistical Service announces the publication of the bimonthly bulletin «Monthly Economic Developments» for the period January–April 2026. The bulletin includes the most important economic developments for the Cyprus Economy, for the latest months up to April 2026, as well as comparative data for the last four years, which were available until the 16th of June 2026.



Note: The Trend component depicts the long-term evolution of the series, that can be observed over a long period of time. It is the result of influences such as population growth, technological development and general economic development.

**Manufacturing Production** during the period January-March 2026 recorded an increase of 0,5% compared to January-March 2025.

The total area of **Building Permits Authorized** reached 661,4 thousand square metres during the period January-February 2026, recording an increase of 54,9% compared to January-February 2025.

The total **Registrations of Motor Vehicles** increased by 15,1%, reaching to 18.570 during the period January-April 2026. Private saloon cars increased to 12.866, recording an increase of 18,2% and light goods vehicles increased to 1.781 recording a rise of 13,4% compared to January-April 2025.

The **Consumer Price Index** increased by 1,1% during the period January-April 2026, compared to the corresponding period of the previous year.

The total **Imports of Goods** amounted to €4.697,0 mn during the period January-April 2026, recording an increase of 4,8% and total **Exports of Goods** amounted to €1.639,9 mn, recording a decrease of 9,3%.

The **Arrivals of Tourists** totaled 710.370 during the period January-April 2026, compared to 865.326 in the corresponding period of 2025, recording a decrease of 17,9%.
