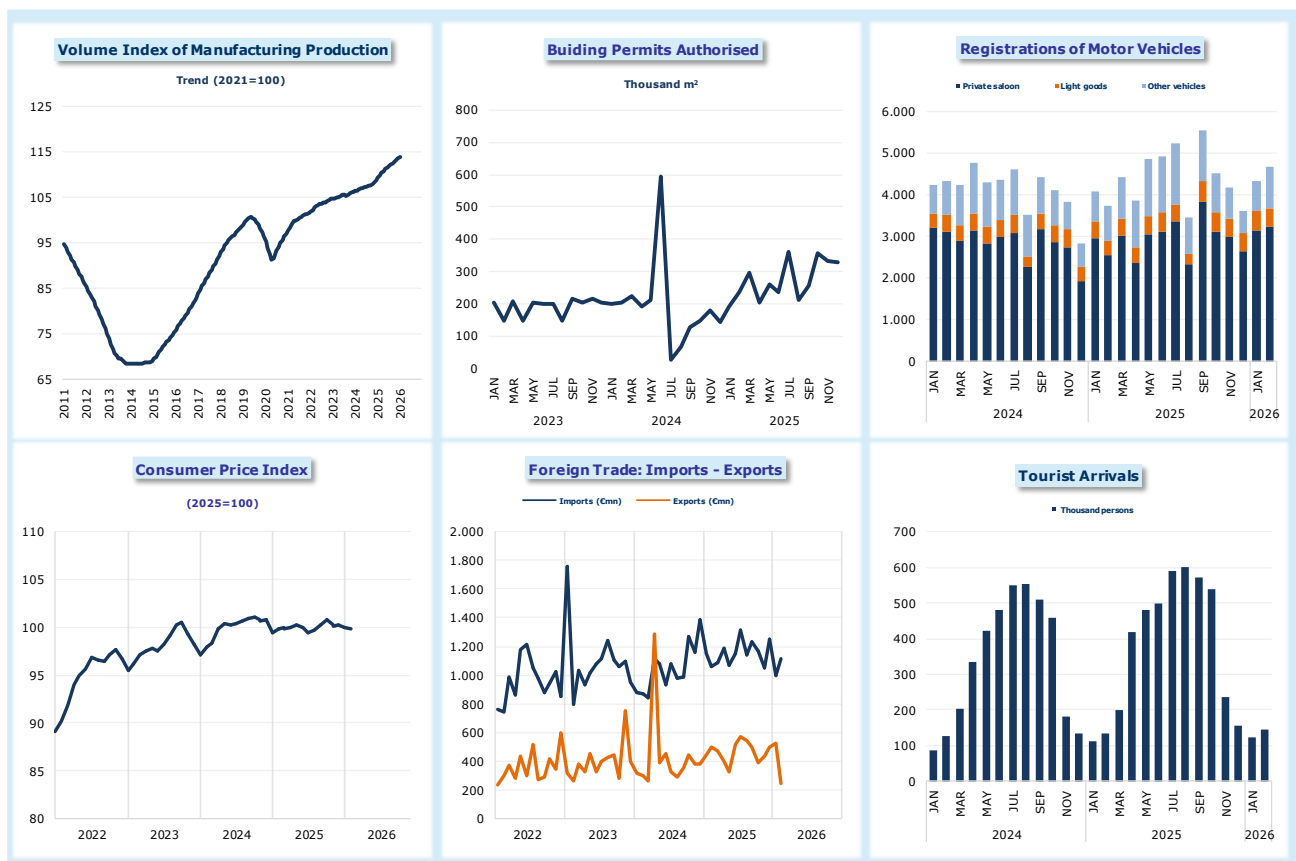

MONTHLY ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENTS: **JANUARY-FEBRUARY 2026**

The Statistical Service announces the publication of the bimonthly bulletin «Monthly Economic Developments» for the period January–February 2026. The bulletin includes the most important economic developments for the Cyprus Economy, for the latest months up to February 2026, as well as comparative data for the last four years, which were available until the 16th of April 2026.



Note: The Trend component depicts the long-term evolution of the series, that can be observed over a long period of time. It is the result of influences such as population growth, technological development and general economic development.

Manufacturing Production during the month January 2026 recorded an increase of 1,5% compared to January 2025.

The total area of **Building Permits Authorized** reached 3.274,2 thousand square metres during the period January-December 2025, recording an increase of 41,0% compared to January-December 2024.

The total **Registrations of Motor Vehicles** increased by 15,1%, reaching to 9.020 during the period January-February 2026. Private saloon cars increased to 6.381, recording an increase of 16,2% and light goods vehicles increased to 919 recording a rise of 18,7% compared to January-February 2025.

The **Consumer Price Index** increased by 0,3% during the period January-February 2026, compared to the corresponding period of the previous year.

The total **Imports of Goods** amounted to €2.108,0 mn during the period January-February 2026, recording a decrease of 4,5% and total **Exports of Goods** amounted to €766,2 mn, recording also a decrease of 18,5%.

The **Arrivals of Tourists** totaled 268.141 during the period January-February 2026, compared to 245.860 in the corresponding period of 2025, recording an increase of 9,1%.
