

FISCAL ACCOUNTS OF GENERAL GOVERNMENT: JAN 2025

Surplus €566,9 mn

The preliminary General Government fiscal results, which are prepared by the Statistical Service of Cyprus (CYSTAT) indicate a surplus of \in 566,9 mn (1,6% of GDP) for January 2025, as compared to a surplus of \notin 476,5 mn (1,4% of GDP) that was recorded during January 2024.



<u>Revenue</u>

During January 2025, total revenue increased by \in 194,3 mn (+14,3%) and amounted to \in 1.554,9 mn, compared to \in 1.360,6 mn in the corresponding month of 2024.

In detail, taxes on production and imports increased by $\notin 40,2 \text{ mn} (+11,3\%)$ and amounted to $\notin 396,3 \text{ mn}$, compared to $\notin 356,1 \text{ mn}$ in 2024, of which net VAT revenue increased by $\notin 8,4 \text{ mn} (+3,5\%)$ and amounted to $\notin 249,7 \text{ mn}$, compared to $\notin 241,3 \text{ mn}$ in 2024. Revenue from taxes on income and wealth increased by $\notin 52,2 \text{ mn} (+9,7\%)$ and amounted to $\notin 592,7 \text{ mn}$, compared to $\notin 540,5 \text{ mn}$ in 2024. Property income increased by $\notin 2,8 \text{ mn} (+37,4\%)$ and amounted to $\notin 10,3 \text{ mn}$, compared to $\notin 7,5 \text{ mn}$ in 2024. Revenue from the sale of goods and services increased by 56,6 mn and amounted to $\notin 109,3 \text{ mn}$, compared to $\notin 52,7 \text{ mn}$ in 2024. Social contributions increased by $\notin 29,9 \text{ mn} (+7,8\%)$ and amounted to $\notin 415,1 \text{ mn}$, compared to $\notin 385,2 \text{ mn}$ in 2024. Current transfers increased by $\notin 14,5 \text{ mn} (+97,5\%)$ and amounted to $\notin 29,3 \text{ mn}$, compared to $\notin 14,8 \text{ mn}$ in 2024.

On the contrary, capital transfers decreased by $\in 1,8$ mn (-50,4%) to $\in 1,8$ mn, from $\in 3,6$ mn in 2024.

Expenditure

During January 2025, total expenditure increased by $\leq 103.9 \text{ mn} (+11.8\%)$ and amounted to $\leq 988.0 \text{ mn}$, compared to $\leq 884.1 \text{ mn}$ in the corresponding month of 2024.

In detail, intermediate consumption increased by $\in 0.5 \text{ mn} (+0,7\%)$ and amounted to $\in 77,6 \text{ mn}$, compared to $\in 77,1 \text{ mn}$ in 2024. Compensation of employees (including imputed social contributions and pensions of civil servants) increased by $\in 28,4 \text{ mn} (+9,9\%)$ and amounted to $\in 314,3 \text{ mn}$, compared to $\in 285,9 \text{ mn}$ in 2024. Social benefits increased by $\in 49,6 \text{ mn} (+12,5\%)$ and amounted to $\in 445,7 \text{ mn}$, compared to $\in 336,1 \text{ mn}$ in 2024. Interest payable increased by $\in 0.6 \text{ mn} (+1,7\%)$ and amounted to $\in 33,5 \text{ mn}$, compared to $\in 34,9 \text{ mn}$ in 2024. Subsidies increased by $\in 4,4 \text{ mn}$ and amounted to $\in 8,7 \text{ mn}$, compared to $\in 4,3 \text{ mn}$ in 2024. Current transfers increased by $\in 13,1 \text{ mn} (+21,3\%)$ and amounted to $\in 74,6 \text{ mn}$, compared to $\notin 61,5 \text{ mn}$ in 2024.

The capital account increased by \in 7,3 mn (+29,8%) and amounted to \in 31,6 mn, compared to \in 24,3 mn in 2024, of which gross capital formation increased by \in 2,7 mn (+10,4%) and amounted to \in 28,1 mn, compared to \in 25,4 mn in 2024.

Important Notice

It is emphasized that for the Local Government Subsector, estimates have been produced by the Statistical Service, due to non-submission of data by the competent authorities for the District Self-Government Organizations and the Municipal Authorities.

METHODOLOGICAL INFORMATION

Data Coverage and Methodology

Information is provided for the whole sequence of accounts for the General Government sector. The revenue and expenditure are analyzed by category and these are classified between current and capital, respectively.

The categories of revenue and expenditure for General Government cover all the subsectors of the General Government based on the European System of Accounts 2010 (ESA 2010).

Source of Data

The data is collected from:

- Financial Information Management Automation System (FIMAS) for Central Government, Extra Budgetary Funds and Social Security Funds,

- Budget execution of Municipalities and Communities,

- Budget execution of Semi-Government Organizations.

For the completion of the estimates, any methodological adjustments or corrections based on the European System of Accounts 2010 (ESA 2010) are taken into account.
