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PREFACE

This report is issued on a monthly basis and aims at providing a general view of the external trade of Cyprus and its partner countries for February 2026. It is divided into three parts. Part A pertains to total trade statistics under the general trade system, part B to extra-EU trade statistics under the special trade system and part C to intra-EU trade statistics. All values shown in the tables of this report are in euros.

The statistics on the trade of goods with non-EU countries (extra-EU trade) are compiled mainly from the computerized systems of the customs authority for imports and for exports. The statistics on the trade of goods with EU countries (intra-EU trade) are compiled mainly via the Intrastat system and the data collected via the VAT returns.

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The valuable cooperation of the Department of Customs and Excise and the Tax Department is acknowledged.

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INTRODUCTION

DEVELOPMENTS IN EXTERNAL TRADE FOR FEBRUARY 2026

Total imports (covering total imports from third countries and from EU Member States) in January – February 2026 amounted to €2.113,1 mn as compared to €2.207,6 mn in January – February 2025.

Total exports (covering total exports to third countries and to EU Member States) in January – February 2026 were €769,7 mn as compared to €939,9 mn in January – February 2025.

As a result, the trade deficit was €1.343,4 mn in January – February 2026 as compared to €1.267,7 mn in the corresponding period of 2025.

Total imports in January – February 2026 include the transfer of economic ownership of mobile transport equipment (vessels), with total value of €256,2 mn as compared to €88,5 mn in January – February 2025. Total exports in January – February 2026 include the transfer of economic ownership of mobile transport equipment (vessels), with total value of €210,6 mn as compared to €108,2 mn in January – February 2025. In addition, total imports include the transfer of economic ownership of mobile transport equipment (aircraft), with total value of €7,1 mn in January – February 2026.

Total imports

Imported goods were €1.120,5 mn in February 2026 and €1.056,4 mn in February 2025.

a. Total imports by HS section

For February 2026 section XVII ‘Vehicles, aircraft, vessels and associated transport equipment’ leads the list with €269,6 mn followed by V ‘Mineral products’ with €185,8 mn, section XVI ‘Machinery and mechanical appliances, electrical equipment and parts’ with €121,7 mn, section VI ‘Products of the chemical or allied industries’ with €117,1 mn, section IV ‘Prepared foodstuffs, beverages, spirits and vinegar, tobacco and manufactured tobacco substitutes’ with €95,4 mn, section XV ‘Base metal and articles of base metal’ with €51,4 mn, section XI ‘Textiles and textile articles’ with €41,4 mn, section I ‘Live animals, animal products’ with €35,1 mn, section VII ‘Plastics and articles thereof, rubber and articles thereof’ with €33,0 mn and section II ‘Vegetable Products’ with €32,8 mn.

b. Total imports by economic destination

- Consumer goods valued at €330,5 mn or 29,5% in February 2026 and €304,3 mn or 28,8% in the respective month of 2025.
- Intermediate inputs valued at €233,3 mn or 20,8% in February 2026 as against €252,2 mn or 23,9% in February 2025. The manufacturing sector absorbed €139,4 mn in February 2026 as compared to €167,8 mn in February 2025. Raw materials for the construction sector were €45,5 mn in February 2026 and €41,3 mn February 2025.
- Transport equipment with their parts accounted for €294,8 mn in February 2026 as compared to €127,5 mn in February 2025. Ships, boats and floating structures valued at €177,8 mn in February 2026 as compared to €9,3 mn in February 2025. Passenger motor vehicles were €63,7 mn in February 2026 and €81,1 mn in February 2025.
- Fuels and lubricants, including crude petroleum oil, valued at €183,8 mn in February 2026 and €285,8 mn in the corresponding month of 2025.
- Capital goods valued at €68,0 mn in February 2026 and €66,0 mn in February 2025. Capital goods for the manufacturing sector accounted for €14,2 mn in February 2026 as against €13,0 mn in February 2025. Capital goods for the construction and mining sectors valued at €7,7 mn in February 2026 and €5,9 mn in February 2025. The transport, storage and communication sector valued at €9,5 mn in February 2026 and €10,2 mn in February 2025. Capital goods for agriculture accounted for €2,3 mn in February 2026 and February 2025, respectively.

c. Total imports by area

- The European Union continued to be the main source of supply of goods to Cyprus in February 2026 with a share of €678,3 mn of total imports. The major suppliers within the Union were Greece with €263,3 mn, the Netherlands with €108,5 mn, Italy with €95,2 mn, Germany with €54,4 mn, Spain with €27,9 mn, France with €24,1 mn, Belgium with €19,7 mn, Romania with €12,9 mn, Bulgaria with €10,8 mn and Poland with €9,8 mn.
- Imports from all other European countries/territories totaled €54,3 mn in February 2026. The major suppliers were the United Kingdom with €30,7 mn, Switzerland with €11,6 mn and Turkey with €3,6 mn.
- Imports from the rest of the world in February 2026 amounted to €387,9 mn. The major partner countries were China with €155,2 mn, Israel with €47,3 mn, Japan with €35,4 mn, the United States with €24,1 mn, India with €11,1 mn, Egypt with €10,2 mn, Seychelles with €7,1 mn, Argentina with €5,9 mn, Viet Nam with €5,5 mn and the United Arab Emirates with €5,2 mn.

d. Total imports destined for home use by economic destination

Imported goods destined for home use were €1.010,9 mn in February 2026 and €800,3 mn in February 2025.

- Consumer goods valued at €306,4 mn or 30,3% and €283,7 mn or 35,5% in February 2026 and February 2025, respectively.
- Intermediate inputs valued at €221,5 mn or 21,9% in February 2026 as against €241,2 mn or 30,1% in February 2025. The manufacturing sector absorbed €129,4 mn in February 2026 and €160,7 mn in February 2025.
- Transport equipment with their parts accounted for €292,6 mn in February 2026 as compared with €119,1 mn in February 2025. Ships, boats and floating structures valued at €177,8 mn in February 2026 as compared with €9,3 mn in February 2025. Passenger motor vehicles were €63,1 mn in February 2026 and €74,1 mn in February 2025.
- Fuels and lubricants, including crude petroleum oil, valued at €114,5 mn in February 2026 and €71,3 mn in the corresponding month of 2025.
- Capital goods valued at €65,7 mn in February 2026 and €64,5 mn in February 2025. Capital goods for the manufacturing sector accounted for €13,3 mn in February 2026 as against €12,6 mn in February 2025. Capital goods for the construction and mining sectors valued at €7,4 mn in February 2026 and €5,8 mn in February 2025. The transport, storage and communication sector absorbed €9,4 mn in February 2026 as against €10,1 mn in February 2025. Capital goods for agriculture accounted for €2,3 mn in February 2026 and February 2025, respectively.

Total exports

Total exports, including stores and provisions, accounted for €244,4 mn in February 2026 as compared with €496,2 mn in February 2025.

a. Total exports, including stores and provisions, by HS section

For February 2026 section V 'Mineral products' leads the list with €71,9 mn followed by section VI 'Products of the chemical or allied industries' with €57,2 mn, section I 'Live animals, animal products' with €35,7 mn, section XVI 'Machinery electrical equipment and parts' with €16,1 mn, section XVII 'Vehicles, aircraft, vessels and associated transport equipment' with €13,0 mn, section IV 'Prepared foodstuffs, beverages, spirits and vinegar, tobacco and manufactured tobacco substitutes' with €11,8 mn, section XV 'Base metal and articles of base metal' with €10,7 mn, section XVIII 'Optical, photographic, cinematographic, measuring, checking, precision, medical or surgical instruments and apparatus, etc.' with €7,6 mn and section II 'Vegetable products' with €4,9 mn.

b. Total exports of domestically produced goods, excluding stores and provisions, by category

- Industrial products of domestic produce exported during February 2026 valued at €143,2 mn or 93,6% of the total, compared to €311,7 mn or 96,9% in February 2025.
- Exports of raw agricultural products valued at €9,3 mn or 6,1% in February 2026 and €9,5 mn or 3,0% in the corresponding month of 2025.
- Mineral exports valued at €0,5 mn or 0,3% in February 2026 and €0,6 mn or 0,2% in February 2025.

c. Total exports by area

- Exports to the European Union accounted for €93,2 mn in February 2026. Exports to Greece accounted for €30,1 mn, to Germany for €7,2 mn, to France for €6,5 mn, to Italy for €5,6 mn, to Sweden for €4,3 mn, to Romania for €3,9 mn, to the Netherlands for €3,0 mn, to Poland for €2,5 mn, to Spain for €2,4 mn and to Austria and Bulgaria for €1,9 mn.
- Exports to Near and Middle Eastern countries/territories accounted for €37,3 mn, to North Africa for €34,9 mn, to other European countries/territories for €20,4 mn, to other African countries/territories for €15,1 mn, to other Asian countries/territories for €10,7 mn, to other countries/territories of Oceania and Polar regions for €10,6 mn and to North America for €6,0 mn in February 2026.
- Stores and provisions to ships and aircraft accounted for €21,8 mn and exports to countries and territories not specified for €0,5 mn in February 2026.

APPENDIX

DEFINITIONS OF TERMS USED

Intra-EU imports

Intra-EU imports include:

- (i) Union goods, except goods which are in transit between Member States;
- (ii) non-Union goods formerly placed in the Member State of export under the inward processing customs procedure, which are maintained under the inward processing customs procedure or released for free circulation in the Member State of import.
- (iii) Some goods movements are included in statistics based on specific conditions e.g. aircraft and ships whose economic ownership has been transferred from a person established in another Member State to a person established in Cyprus are included in intra-EU imports statistics.

Intra-EU exports

Intra-EU exports include:

- (i) Union goods, except goods which are in transit between Member States;
- (ii) non-Union goods placed in the Member State of export under the inward processing customs procedure.
- (iii) Some goods movements are included in statistics based on specific conditions e.g. aircraft and ships whose economic ownership has been transferred from a person established in Cyprus to a person established in another Member State are included in intra-EU exports statistics.

Commodity classification

The commodity classification is based on the Harmonised Commodity Description and Coding System (HS) or more simply the Harmonised System or HS (6 digits level) and includes more than 5.000 six-digit codes.

The Harmonised System is a legal instrument and was adopted by the Customs Co-operation Council (now the World Customs Organisation) in June 1983 and the International Convention on the Harmonised System (HS Convention) entered into force on the 1st January 1988. The HS is a nomenclature comprising of headings and sub-headings and their related numerical codes, sections, chapters as well as notes and general rules for its interpretation.

Most detailed results are available by the sub-headings of the Combined Nomenclature (CN), which includes nearly 10.000 eight-digit codes.

The structure of the HS and the CN classifications (for the reference year 2026) is illustrated in the following table:

Country classification

The classification of countries is based on the nomenclature of countries and territories, as set out in the Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2020/1470. From January 1999, the United Nations ISO alpha-2 coding system is followed, in which each country is identified by a two-letter code.

Partner country

In this publication, **intra-EU exports** and **extra-EU exports** are classified by the Member State and country of final destination of the goods, respectively. The last country to which the goods are specifically directed on their outward movement from the reporting country is regarded as their final destination. This is not necessarily the country in which the good will be unshipped or that in which they will be finally consumed.

For **extra-EU imports**, the trading partner is the country of origin. In general, goods obtained entirely from a given country originate in that country. A product in the production of which two or more countries were involved, is considered as originating in the country in which the last substantial transformation or processing took place. Packing, repacking and sorting are not regarded as manufacturing processes.

For **intra-EU imports**, the trading partner is the Member State of consignment of the goods. This is the Member State from which the goods were dispatched without halt or legal formality in another country apart from any transport reasons. Conversely, if there was such an operation in another country, that country becomes the Member State of consignment.

The United Kingdom is considered as an extra-EU partner country for the EU. Imports from the United Kingdom are recorded by country of consignment until the end of the transitory period (31 December 2020). As of January 2021 onwards, data on trade with the United Kingdom is based on a mixed concept. In application of the Withdrawal Agreement Protocol on Ireland / Northern Ireland, for trade with Northern Ireland the statistical concepts applicable are the same as those for trade between Member States (imports are recorded by country of consignment) while for trade with the United Kingdom (excluding Northern Ireland) the same statistical concepts are applicable as for trade with any other extra-EU partner country (imports are recorded by country of origin). For these reasons data on trade with the United Kingdom are not fully comparable with data on trade with other extra-EU trade partners, and for reference periods before and after the end of 2020.

Trade systems

There are broadly two approaches, closely linked with customs procedures, used for the measurement of international trade in goods: the general trade system and the special trade system.

General trade system

The general trade system is the wider concept and under it the recorded aggregates include goods entering or leaving the economic territory of Cyprus with the exception of simple transit trade or transshipment of goods. Quasi transit trade is included in general imports and exports statistics. In particular, goods which are received into customs warehouses are recorded as imports at that stage whether or not they subsequently go into free circulation in Cyprus. Similarly, outgoing goods from customs warehouses are included in the general trade aggregates at the time they leave Cyprus.

Special trade system

The special trade system is a narrower concept. Goods from a non-EU country which are received into customs warehouses are not recorded in the special trade aggregates unless they subsequently go into free circulation in Cyprus (or are placed under the customs procedures for inward processing). Similarly, outgoing goods from customs warehouses are not recorded as exports.

Stores and provisions

Stores and provisions denote vessels and aircraft stores and supplies. Vessels and aircraft stores mean the various products for consumption by the crew and passengers. Vessels and aircraft supplies means the products for the operation of the engines, machines and other equipment on vessels or aircraft, such as fuel, oil and lubricants.

Domestic and foreign goods

Domestic goods are goods originating in the economic territory of Cyprus; if they have been wholly obtained in it or were substantially transformed by processing in it, so that the processing confers domestic origin. Goods originally imported and having undergone only repair or minor operations, which leave them essentially unchanged are not defined as domestic. Minor operations include packaging, bottling, cleaning, sorting etc.

Foreign goods are goods originating in the rest of the world, i.e. not included in the economic territory of Cyprus and compensating goods obtained under the outward processing procedure when such processing confers foreign origin.
