PREFACE

This report is issued on a monthly basis and aims at providing a general view of the external trade of Cyprus and its partner countries for January 2022. It is divided into three parts. Part A pertains to total trade statistics under the general trade system, part B to extra-EU trade statistics under the special trade system and part C to intra-EU trade statistics. All values shown in the tables of this report are in euros.

The statistics on the trade of goods with non-EU countries (extra-EU trade) are compiled mainly from the computerized systems of the customs authority for imports ("Theseas" system) and for exports. The statistics on the trade of goods with EU countries (intra-EU trade) are compiled mainly via the Intrastat system and the data collected via the VAT returns.

This report was prepared by Mrs. Ioanna Leontiou, Statistics Officer, under the guidance of Mr. Sofronis Vikis, Senior Statistics Officer and the general supervision of Mr. Pantelis Protopapas, Head of the Business, Energy, Environment, Agriculture, Science and Technology and Foreign Trade Statistics Division.

INTRODUCTION

DEVELOPMENTS IN EXTERNAL TRADE FOR JANUARY 2022

Total imports (covering total imports from third countries and from EU Member States) in January 2022 amounted to €746,0 mn as compared to €590,6 mn in January 2021.

Total exports (covering total exports to third countries and to EU Member States) in January 2022 were €222,4 mn compared to €156,3 mn in January 2021. As a result, the trade deficit was €523,6 mn in January 2022 compared to €434,3 mn in the corresponding period of 2021.

Total imports in January 2022 include the transfer of economic ownership of mobile transport equipment (vessels), with total value of \in 73,7 mn as compared to \in 118,1 mn in January 2021. Total exports in January 2022 include the transfer of economic ownership of mobile transport equipment (vessels), with total value of \in 63,7 mn as compared to \in 24,6 mn in January 2021.

In addition, total exports include the transfer of economic ownership of mobile transport equipment (aircraft), with total value of €11,1 mn for January 2021.

Total imports

a. Total imports by HS section

For January 2022 section V 'Mineral products' leads the list with $\in 166,2$ mn followed by section XVII 'Vehicles, aircraft, vessels and associated transport equipment' with $\in 125,1$ mn, section VI 'Products of the chemical or allied industries' with $\in 83,1$ mn, section XVI 'Machinery and mechanical appliances, electrical equipment and parts' with $\in 79,6$ mn, section IV 'Prepared foodstuffs, beverages, spirits and vinegar, tobacco and manufactured tobacco substitutes' with $\in 67,6$ mn, section XV 'Base metal and articles of base metal' with $\in 31,6$ mn, section II 'Vegetable products' with $\in 28,2$ mn, section VII 'Plastics and articles thereof; rubber and articles' with $\in 26,4$ mn, section XI 'Textiles and textile articles' with $\in 21,5$ mn and section XX 'Miscellaneous manufactured articles' with $\in 20,6$ mn.

b. Total imports by economic destination

- Consumer goods valued at €195,7 mn or 26,2% in January 2022 and €147,9 mn or 25,1% in the respective month of 2021.
- Intermediate inputs valued at €203,8 mn or 27,3% in January 2022 as against €151,5 mn or 25,7% in January 2021. The manufacturing sector absorbed €136,4 mn in January 2022 as compared with €97,6 mn in January 2021. Raw materials for the construction sector were €29,3 mn in January 2022 and €20,8 mn in January 2021.
- Transport equipment with their parts accounted for €135,3 mn in January 2022 as compared with €188,4 mn in January 2021. Ships, boats and floating structures valued at €73,8 mn in January 2022 as compared with €121,0 mn in January 2021. Passenger motor vehicles were €41,4 mn in January 2022 and €46,8 mn in January 2021.
- Fuels and lubricants, including crude petroleum oil, valued at €150,4 mn in January 2022 and €59,8 mn in the corresponding month of 2021.
- Capital goods valued at €43,5 mn in January 2022 and €39,5 mn in January 2021. Capital goods for the manufacturing sector accounted for €7,1 mn in January 2022 as against €7,4 mn in January 2021. Capital goods for the construction and mining sectors valued at €5,9 mn in January 2022 and €5,7 mn in January 2021. The transport, storage and communication sector valued at €8,3 mn in January 2022 and €8,7 mn in January 2021. Capital goods for agriculture accounted for €1,2 mn in January 2022 and for €1,7 mn in January 2021.

c. Total imports by area

- The European Union continued to be the main source of supply of goods to Cyprus in January 2022 with a share of €520,8 mn of total imports. The major suppliers within the Union were Greece with €158,3 mn, Italy with €76,6 mn, Germany with €63,6 mn, the Netherlands with €48,3 mn, Spain with €41,2 mn, Malta with €30,7 mn, Belgium with €16,3 mn, France with €10,4 mn, Bulgaria with €10,0 mn and Romania with €7,2 mn.
- Imports from all other European countries totaled €47,7 mn in January 2022. The major suppliers were the United Kingdom with €19,1 mn, Turkey with €9,6 mn, Moldova with €5,6 mn and Russia with €5,5 mn.
- Imports from the rest of the world in January 2022 amounted to €177,5 mn. The major partner countries were China with €51,8 mn, Israel with €50,4 mn, Japan with €10,1 mn, Argentina with €9,9 mn, India with €6,4 mn, the United Arab Emirates with €5,1 mn, the United States with €5,0 mn, Viet-Nam with €3,8 mn, South Korea with €3,7 mn and Kazakhstan with €3,2 mn.

d. Total imports destined for home use by economic destination

Imported goods destined for home use were €688,1 mn in January 2022 and €559,4 mn in January 2021.

- Consumer goods valued at €184,5 mn or 26,8% and €142,2 mn or 25,4% in January 2022 and January 2021, respectively.
- Intermediate inputs valued at €199,1 mn or 28,9% in January 2022 as against €150,5 mn or 26,9% in January 2021. The manufacturing sector absorbed €133,6 mn in January 2022 and €97,0 mn in January 2021.
- Transport equipment with their parts accounted for €129,3 mn in January 2022 as compared with €184,8 mn in January 2021. Ships, boats and floating structures valued at €73,8 mn in January 2022 as compared with €121,3 mn in January 2021. Passenger motor vehicles were €36,2 mn in January 2022 and €43,4 mn in January 2021.
- Fuels and lubricants, including crude petroleum oil, valued at €116,2 mn in January 2022 and €40,2 mn in the corresponding month of 2021.
- Capital goods valued at €41,6 mn in January 2022 and €38,2 mn in January 2021. Capital goods for the manufacturing sector accounted for €6,7 mn in January 2022 as against €6,7 mn in January 2021. Capital goods for the construction and mining sectors valued at €5,7 mn for both January 2022 and January 2021. The transport, storage and communication sector absorbed €8,1 mn in January 2022 as against €8,7 mn in January 2021. Capital goods for agriculture accounted for €1,0 mn in January 2022 and for €1,7 mn in January 2021.

Total exports

a. Total exports, including stores and provisions, by HS section

For January 2022 section XVII 'Vehicles, aircraft, vessels and associated transport equipment' leads the list with \in 65,4 mn followed by section V 'Mineral products' with \in 38,6 mn, section VI 'Products of the chemical or allied industries' with \in 38,1 mn, section I 'Live animals, animal products' with \in 21,3 mn, section XVI 'Machinery electrical equipment and parts' with \in 19,2 mn, section XV 'Base metal and articles of base metal' with \in 7,7 mn, section IV 'Prepared foodstuffs, beverages, spirits and vinegar, tobacco and manufactured tobacco substitutes' with \in 7,3 mn, section II 'Vegetable products' with \in 6,0 mn, section XIV 'Natural or cultured pearls, precious or semi-precious stones, precious metals, jewellery, coins, etc' with \in 4,0 mn, section XVIII 'Optical, photographic, cinematographic, measuring, checking, precision, medical or surgical instruments, clocks and watches, musical instruments, parts and accessories thereof' with \in 3,1 mn and section VII 'Plastics and articles thereof, rubber and articles thereof' with \in 2,5 mn.

b. Total exports of domestically produced goods, excluding stores and provisions, by category

- Industrial products of domestic produce exported during January 2022 valued at €93,9 mn or 93,1% of the total, compared to €76,8 mn or 90,2% in January 2021.
- Exports of raw agricultural products valued at €6,6 mn or 6,6% in January 2022 and €7,6 mn or 9,0% in the corresponding month of 2021.
- Mineral exports valued at €0,4 mn or 0,4% in January 2022 and €0,4 mn or 0,5% in January 2021.

c. Total exports by area

- Exports to the European Union accounted for €70,7 mn in January 2022. Exports to Greece accounted for €23,2 mn, to Italy for €7,7 mn, to Germany for €5,3 mn, to Romania for €2,9 mn, to Czechia for €2,7 mn, to Estonia for €2,6 mn, to France for €2,4 mn, to Spain and Sweden for €2,0 mn each, to Bulgaria for €1,7 mn and to the Netherlands for €1,6 mn.
- Exports to other countries of Oceania and Polar regions accounted for €37,5 mn, to Near and Middle eastern countries for €33,1 mn, to other European countries for €22,5 mn, to other Asian countries for €11,8 mn, to other African countries for €8,7 mn, to north America for €6,7 mn, to north Africa for €6,5 mn and to central America and Caribbean for €4,5 mn in January 2022.
- Stores and provisions to ships and aircrafts in January 2022 valued at €22,1 mn, exports to countries and territories not specified amounted to €2,5 mn and exports to high seas amounted to €0,8 mn in January 2022.

APPENDIX	

DEFINITIONS OF TERMS USED

Intra-EU Imports

Intra-EU imports include:

- a) Goods in free circulation which enter the statistical territory of Cyprus.
- b) Goods which have been placed under the customs procedure for inward processing or processing under customs control (for processing, transformation) in another Member State and which enter the statistical territory of Cyprus.
- c) Certain goods are included in statistics based on specific conditions e.g. vessels and aircraft whose economic ownership has been transferred from a natural person or legal entity established in another Member State to a natural person or legal entity established in Cyprus are included in the statistics of intra-EU imports of Cyprus.

Intra-EU Exports

Intra-EU exports include:

- a) Goods in free circulation which leave the statistical territory of Cyprus bound for another Member State.
- b) Goods which have been placed under the customs procedure for inward processing or processing under customs control (for processing, transformation) in Cyprus and which are destined for another Member State.
- c) Certain goods are included in statistics based on specific conditions e.g. vessels and aircraft whose economic ownership has been transferred from a natural person or legal entity established in the Cyprus to a natural person or legal entity established in another Member State are included in the statistics of intra-EU exports of Cyprus.

Extra-EU Imports

Extra-EU imports under special trade system include:

- a) Goods, which enter the statistical territory of Cyprus from a non-Member State country and are:
- Placed under the customs procedure for release into free circulation (goods intended to be consumed in Cyprus or dispatched to another Member State), either immediately or after a period in a customs warehouse; or
- Placed under the customs procedure for inward processing of processing under customs control (usually goods destined to be processed, transformed for subsequent re-export) either immediately or after a period in a customs warehouse,
- b) Certain goods are included in statistics based on specific conditions e.g. vessels and aircraft whose economic ownership has been transferred from a natural or legal person established in a non-Member State country to a natural person or legal entity established in Cyprus are included in the statistics of extra-EU imports of Cyprus.

Extra-EU Exports

Extra-EU exports under special trade system include:

- a) Goods that leave the statistical territory of Cyprus bound for a non-Member State country, having gone through:
- The customs export procedure (final export, export following inward processing, etc.); or
- The customs outward-processing procedure (usually goods destined to be processed, transformed for subsequent re-import).

b) Certain goods are included in statistics based on specific conditions e.g. vessels and aircraft whose economic ownership has been transferred from a natural or legal person established in Cyprus to a natural person or legal entity established in a non-Member State country are included in the statistics of extra-EU exports of Cyprus.

Commodity classification

The commodity classification is based on the Harmonised Commodity Description and Coding System (HS) or more simply the Harmonised System or HS (6 digits level) and includes more than 5.000 six-digit codes.

The Harmonised System is a legal instrument and was adopted by the Customs Co-operation Council (now the World Customs Organisation) in June 1983 and the International Convention on the Harmonised System (HS Convention) entered into force on the 1st January 1988. The HS is a nomenclature comprising of headings and sub-headings and their related numerical codes, sections, chapters, as well as notes and general rules for its interpretation.

Most detailed results are available by the sub-headings of the Combined Nomenclature (CN), which includes nearly 10.000 eight-digit codes.

The structure of the HS and the CN classifications (for the reference year 2022) is illustrated in the following table:

Country classification

The classification of countries is based on the nomenclature of countries and territories, as set out in the Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2020/1470. From January 1999, the United Nations ISO alpha-2 coding system is followed, in which each country is identified by a two-letter code.

Partner country

For extra-EU & intra-EU exports, the trading partner is the non-EU country or Member State of final destination of the goods. The last country to which the goods are specifically directed on their outward movement from Cyprus is regarded as their final destination. This is not necessarily the country in which the good will be unshipped or that in which they will be finally consumed.

For extra-EU imports, the trading partner is the country of origin. In general, goods obtained entirely from a given country originate in that country. A product in the production of which two or more countries were involved, is considered as originating in the country in which the

last substantial transformation or processing took place. Packing, repacking and sorting are not regarded as manufacturing processes.

For intra-EU imports, the trading partner is the Member State of consignment of the goods. This is the Member State from which the goods were dispatched without halt or legal formality in another country apart from any transport reasons. Conversely, if there was such an operation in another country, that country becomes the Member State of consignment.

The United Kingdom is considered as an extra-EU partner country for the EU. Imports from the United Kingdom are recorded by country of consignment until the end of the transitory period (31 December 2020). As of January 2021 onwards, data on trade with the United Kingdom is based on a mixed concept. In application of the Withdrawal Agreement Protocol on Ireland / Northern Ireland, for trade with Northern Ireland the statistical concepts applicable are the same as those for trade between Member States (imports are recorded by country of consignment) while for trade with the United Kingdom (excluding Northern Ireland) the same statistical concepts are applicable as for trade with any other extra-EU partner country (imports are recorded by country of origin). For these reasons data on trade with the United Kingdom are not fully comparable with data on trade with other extra-EU trade partners, and for reference periods before and after the end of 2020.

Trade systems

There are broadly two approaches, closely linked with customs procedures, used for the measurement of international trade in goods: the general trade system and the special trade system.

General trade system

The general trade system is the wider concept and under it the recorded aggregates include goods entering or leaving the economic territory of Cyprus with the exception of simple transit trade or transshipment of goods. Quasi transit trade is included in general imports and exports statistics. In particular, goods which are received into customs warehouses are recorded as imports at that stage whether or not they subsequently go into free circulation in Cyprus. Similarly, outgoing goods from customs warehouses are included in the general trade aggregates at the time they leave Cyprus.

Special trade system

The special trade system is a narrower concept. Goods from a non-EU country which are received into customs warehouses are not recorded in the special trade aggregates unless they subsequently go into free circulation in Cyprus (or are placed under the customs procedures for inward processing).

Similarly, outgoing goods from customs warehouses are not recorded as exports.

Stores and provisions

Stores and provisions denote vessels and aircraft stores and supplies.

Vessels and aircraft stores mean the various products for consumption by the crew and passengers;

Vessels and aircraft supplies means the products for the operation of the engines, machines and other equipment on vessels or aircraft, such as fuel, oil and lubricants.

Domestic and foreign goods

Domestic goods are goods originating in the economic territory of Cyprus; if they have been wholly obtained in it or were substantially transformed by processing in it, so that the processing

confers domestic origin. Goods originally imported and having undergone only repair or minor operations, which leave them essentially unchanged are not defined as domestic. Minor operations include packaging, bottling, cleaning, sorting etc.

Foreign goods are goods originating in the rest of the world, i.e. not included in the economic territory of Cyprus and compensating goods obtained under the outward processing procedure when such processing confers foreign origin.
