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PREFACE

This report is issued on a monthly basis and aims at providing a general view of the external trade of Cyprus and its partner countries for July 2025. It is divided into three parts. Part A pertains to total trade statistics under the general trade system, part B to extra-EU trade statistics under the special trade system and part C to intra-EU trade statistics. All values shown in the tables of this report are in euros.

The statistics on the trade of goods with non-EU countries (extra-EU trade) are compiled mainly from the computerized systems of the customs authority for imports (“Theseas” system) and for exports. The statistics on the trade of goods with EU countries (intra-EU trade) are compiled mainly via the Intrastat system and the data collected via the VAT returns.

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INTRODUCTION

DEVELOPMENTS IN EXTERNAL TRADE FOR JULY 2025

Total imports (covering total imports from third countries and from EU Member States) in January – July 2025 amounted to €7.786,4 mn as compared to €6.799,8 mn in January – July 2024.

Total exports (covering total exports to third countries and to EU Member States) in January – July 2025 were €3.197,9 mn as compared to €3.336,1 mn in January – July 2024.

As a result, the trade deficit was €4.588,5 mn in January – July 2025 as compared to €3.463,7 mn in the corresponding period of 2024.

Total imports in January – July 2025 include the transfer of economic ownership of mobile transport equipment (vessels), with total value of €326,3 mn as compared to €353,9 mn in January – July 2024. Total exports in January – July 2025 include the transfer of economic ownership of mobile transport equipment (vessels), with total value of €405,1 mn as compared to €1.387,0 mn in January – July 2024. In addition, total imports include the transfer of economic ownership of mobile transport equipment (aircraft), with total value of €45,8 mn in January – July 2025 as compared to €68,6 mn in January – July 2024 and total exports in January – July 2025 include the transfer of economic ownership of mobile transport equipment (aircraft), with total value of €3,7 mn as compared to €79,1 mn in January – July 2024.

Total imports

Imported goods were €1.289,2 mn in July 2025 and €1.079,4 mn in July 2024.

a. Total imports by HS section

For July 2025 section V ‘Mineral products’ leads the list with €446,9 mn followed by section VI ‘Products of the chemical or allied industries’ with €143,3 mn, section XVI ‘Machinery and mechanical appliances, electrical equipment and parts’ with €123,6 mn, section XVII ‘Vehicles, aircraft, vessels and associated transport equipment’ with €116,1 mn, section IV ‘Prepared foodstuffs, beverages, spirits and vinegar, tobacco and manufactured tobacco substitutes’ with €105,4 mn, section XV ‘Base metal and articles of base metal’ with €60,9 mn, section II ‘Vegetable Products’ with €43,5 mn, section I ‘Live animals, animal products’ with €42,1 mn, section XI ‘Textiles and textile articles’ with €36,7 mn, section VII ‘Plastics and articles thereof; rubber and articles’ with €34,2 mn and section XX ‘Miscellaneous manufactured articles’ with €33,0 mn.

b. Total imports by economic destination

- Consumer goods valued at €361,0 mn or 28,0% in July 2025 and €350,5 mn or 32,5% in the respective month of 2024.
- Intermediate inputs valued at €314,3 mn or 24,4% in July 2025 as against €301,7 mn or 28,0% in July 2024. The manufacturing sector absorbed €212,8 mn in July 2025 as compared to €197,1 mn in July 2024. Raw materials for the construction sector were €54,1 mn in July 2025 and €54,2 mn July 2024.
- Transport equipment with their parts accounted for €127,9 mn in July 2025 as compared to €135,3 mn in July 2024. Ships, boats and floating structures valued at €23,7 mn in July 2025 as compared to €15,4 mn in July 2024. Passenger motor vehicles were €68,3 mn in July 2025 and €82,0 mn in July 2024.
- Fuels and lubricants, including crude petroleum oil, valued at €409,5 mn in July 2025 and €210,3 mn in the corresponding month of 2024.
- Capital goods valued at €74,9 mn in July 2025 and €76,0 mn in July 2024. Capital goods for the manufacturing sector accounted for €14,0 mn in July 2025 as against €18,6 mn in July 2024. Capital goods for the construction and mining sectors valued at €8,1 mn in July 2025 and €8,4 mn in July 2024. The transport, storage and communication sector valued at €10,5 mn in July 2025 and €10,1 mn in July 2024. Capital goods for agriculture accounted for €2,2 mn in July 2025 and €1,8 mn July 2024.

c. Total imports by area

- The European Union continued to be the main source of supply of goods to Cyprus in July 2025 with a share of €734,8 mn of total imports. The major suppliers within the Union were Greece with €289,1 mn, Italy with €108,2 mn, Spain with €69,0 mn, Germany with €65,7 mn, the Netherlands with €48,9 mn, Belgium with €24,8 mn, France with €22,5 mn, Romania with €18,7 mn, Malta with €13,8 mn, Bulgaria with €12,1 mn, Poland with € 9,6 and Ireland with €9,4 mn.
- Imports from all other European countries/territories totaled €90,9 mn in July 2025. The major suppliers were Turkey with €32,0 mn, the United Kingdom with €31,5 mn and Switzerland with €9,8 mn.
- Imports from the rest of the world in July 2025 amounted to €463,5 mn. The major partner countries were Saudi Arabia with €115,2 mn, China with €65,5 mn, Kuwait with €31,0 mn, Japan with €26,8 mn, Nigeria with €20,9 mn, the United States with €20,5 mn, Egypt with €11,7 mn, Azerbaijan with €10,6 mn, Libya with €7,5 mn, India with €6,5 mn and the United Arab Emirates with €6,4 mn.

d. Total imports destined for home use by economic destination

Imported goods destined for home use were €931,8 mn in July 2025 and €906,4 mn in July 2024.

- Consumer goods valued at €337,7 mn or 36,2% and €335,6 mn or 37,0% in July 2025 and July 2024, respectively.
- Intermediate inputs valued at €290,0 mn or 31,1% in July 2025 as against €278,1 mn or 30,7% in July 2024. The manufacturing sector absorbed €185,2 mn in July 2025 and €174,2 mn in July 2024.
- Transport equipment with their parts accounted for €123,5 mn in July 2025 as compared with €128,2 mn in July 2024. Ships, boats and floating structures valued at €23,7 mn in July 2025 as compared with €15,4 mn in July 2024. Passenger motor vehicles were €65,8 mn in July 2025 and €76,7 mn in July 2024.
- Fuels and lubricants, including crude petroleum oil, valued at €106,5 mn in July 2025 and €85,6 mn in the corresponding month of 2024.
- Capital goods valued at €72,5 mn in July 2025 and €73,4 mn in July 2024. Capital goods for the manufacturing sector accounted for €13,4 mn in July 2025 as against €17,0 mn in July 2024. Capital goods for the construction and mining sectors valued at €7,6 mn in July 2025 and €8,3 mn in July 2024. The transport, storage and communication sector absorbed €10,3 mn in July 2025 as against €9,8 mn in July 2024. Capital goods for agriculture accounted for €2,2 mn in July 2025 as against €1,8 mn in July 2024.

Total exports

Total exports, including stores and provisions, accounted for €565,0 mn in July 2025 as compared with €329,2 mn in July 2024.

a. Total exports, including stores and provisions, by HS section

For July 2025 section V ‘Mineral products’ leads the list with €291,5 mn followed by section XVII ‘Vehicles, aircraft, vessels and associated transport equipment’ with €97,2 mn, section VI ‘Products of the chemical or allied industries’ with €59,0 mn, section I ‘Live animals, animal products’ with €46,2 mn, section XVI ‘Machinery electrical equipment and parts’ with €17,8 mn, section XV ‘Base metal and articles of base metal’ with €14,7 mn, section XVIII ‘Optical, photographic, cinematographic, measuring, checking, precision, medical or surgical instruments, clocks and watches, musical instruments, parts and accessories thereof’ with €5,8 mn, section VII ‘Plastics and articles thereof, rubber and articles thereof’ with €3,6 mn, section II ‘Vegetable products’ with €2,8 mn and section XX ‘Miscellaneous manufactured articles’ with €1,9 mn.

b. Total exports of domestically produced goods, excluding stores and provisions, by category

- Industrial products of domestic produce exported during July 2025 valued at €373,8 mn or 97,5% of the total, compared to €208,6 mn or 96,1% in July 2024.
- Exports of raw agricultural products valued at €8,6 mn or 2,2% in July 2025 and €7,7 mn or 3,6% in the corresponding month of 2024.
- Mineral exports valued at €0,8 mn or 0,2% in July 2025 and €0,7 mn or 0,3% in July 2024.

c. Total exports by area

- Exports to the European Union accounted for €171,4 mn in July 2025. Exports to Sweden accounted for €58,8 mn, to Greece for €37,0 mn, to Germany for €8,8 mn, to Romania for €6,2 mn, to France for €5,1 mn, to Czechia for €4,7 mn, to the Netherlands for €3,4 mn, to Spain for €3,0 mn, to Italy for €2,9 mn and to Denmark for €2,6 mn.
- Exports to Near and Middle Eastern countries/territories accounted for €124,5 mn, to North Africa for €118,0 mn, to other African countries/territories for €47,4 mn, to other European countries/territories for €25,3 mn, to other countries/territories of Oceania and Polar regions for €21,3 mn, to other Asian countries/territories for €15,2 mn and to Central America and the Caribbean for €8,8 mn and in July 2025.
- Stores and provisions to ships and aircraft accounted for €43,4 mn and exports to countries and territories not specified for €1,4 mn in July 2025.

APPENDIX

DEFINITIONS OF TERMS USED

Intra-EU imports

Intra-EU imports include:

- (i) Union goods, except goods which are in transit between Member States;
- (ii) non-Union goods formerly placed in the Member State of export under the inward processing customs procedure, which are maintained under the inward processing customs procedure or released for free circulation in the Member State of import.
- (iii) Some goods movements are included in statistics based on specific conditions e.g. aircraft and ships whose economic ownership has been transferred from a person established in another Member State to a person established in Cyprus are included in intra-EU imports statistics.

Intra-EU exports

Intra-EU exports include:

- (i) Union goods, except goods which are in transit between Member States;
- (ii) non-Union goods placed in the Member State of export under the inward processing customs procedure.
- (iii) Some goods movements are included in statistics based on specific conditions e.g. aircraft and ships whose economic ownership has been transferred from a person established in Cyprus to a person established in another Member State are included in intra-EU exports statistics.

Commodity classification

The commodity classification is based on the Harmonised Commodity Description and Coding System (HS) or more simply the Harmonised System or HS (6 digits level) and includes more than 5.000 six-digit codes.

The Harmonised System is a legal instrument and was adopted by the Customs Co-operation Council (now the World Customs Organisation) in June 1983 and the International Convention on the Harmonised System (HS Convention) entered into force on the 1st January 1988. The HS is a nomenclature comprising of headings and sub-headings and their related numerical codes, sections, chapters as well as notes and general rules for its interpretation.

Most detailed results are available by the sub-headings of the Combined Nomenclature (CN), which includes nearly 10.000 eight-digit codes.

The structure of the HS and the CN classifications (for the reference year 2025) is illustrated in the following table:

Country classification

The classification of countries is based on the nomenclature of countries and territories, as set out in the Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2020/1470. From January 1999, the United Nations ISO alpha-2 coding system is followed, in which each country is identified by a two-letter code.

Partner country

In this publication, **intra-EU exports** and **extra-EU exports** are classified by the Member State and country of final destination of the goods, respectively. The last country to which the goods are specifically directed on their outward movement from the reporting country is regarded as their final destination. This is not necessarily the country in which the good will be unshipped or that in which they will be finally consumed.

For **extra-EU imports**, the trading partner is the country of origin. In general, goods obtained entirely from a given country originate in that country. A product in the production of which two or more countries were involved, is considered as originating in the country in which the last substantial transformation or processing took place. Packing, repacking and sorting are not regarded as manufacturing processes.

For **intra-EU imports**, the trading partner is the Member State of consignment of the goods. This is the Member State from which the goods were dispatched without halt or legal formality in another country apart from any transport reasons. Conversely, if there was such an operation in another country, that country becomes the Member State of consignment.

The United Kingdom is considered as an extra-EU partner country for the EU. Imports from the United Kingdom are recorded by country of consignment until the end of the transitory period (31 December 2020). As of January 2021 onwards, data on trade with the United Kingdom is based on a mixed concept. In application of the Withdrawal Agreement Protocol on Ireland / Northern Ireland, for trade with Northern Ireland the statistical concepts applicable are the same as those for trade between Member States (imports are recorded by country of consignment) while for trade with the United Kingdom (excluding Northern Ireland) the same statistical concepts are applicable as for trade with any other extra-EU partner country (imports are recorded by country of origin). For these reasons data on trade with the United Kingdom are not fully comparable with data on trade with other extra-EU trade partners, and for reference periods before and after the end of 2020.

Trade systems

There are broadly two approaches, closely linked with customs procedures, used for the measurement of international trade in goods: the general trade system and the special trade system.

General trade system

The general trade system is the wider concept and under it the recorded aggregates include goods entering or leaving the economic territory of Cyprus with the exception of simple transit trade or transhipment of goods. Quasi transit trade is included in general imports and exports statistics. In particular, goods which are received into customs warehouses are recorded as imports at that stage whether or not they subsequently go into free circulation in Cyprus. Similarly, outgoing goods from customs warehouses are included in the general trade aggregates at the time they leave Cyprus.

Special trade system

The special trade system is a narrower concept. Goods from a non-EU country which are received into customs warehouses are not recorded in the special trade aggregates unless they subsequently go into free circulation in Cyprus (or are placed under the customs procedures for inward processing). Similarly, outgoing goods from customs warehouses are not recorded as exports.

Stores and provisions

Stores and provisions denote vessels and aircraft stores and supplies. Vessels and aircraft stores mean the various products for consumption by the crew and passengers. Vessels and aircraft supplies means the products for the operation of the engines, machines and other equipment on vessels or aircraft, such as fuel, oil and lubricants.

Domestic and foreign goods

Domestic goods are goods originating in the economic territory of Cyprus; if they have been wholly obtained in it or were substantially transformed by processing in it, so that the processing confers domestic origin. Goods originally imported and having undergone only repair or minor operations, which leave them essentially unchanged are not defined as domestic. Minor operations include packaging, bottling, cleaning, sorting etc.

Foreign goods are goods originating in the rest of the world, i.e. not included in the economic territory of Cyprus and compensating goods obtained under the outward processing procedure when such processing confers foreign origin.

In addition, the Portal contains the "Annual Release Calendar" which presents the release dates of short-term statistics.

Data and electronic publications (pdf) are available on the Portal free of charge. Paper publications are obtainable from the central offices of the Statistical Service in Lefkosa and from the Printing Office of the Republic of Cyprus.

European Statistical Data Support (ESDS)

All the information contained on the website of Eurostat (<https://ec.europa.eu/eurostat>) is available free of charge to all users. Among others, the website offers access to statistical data contained in Eurostat's databases as well as to the publications of Eurostat in electronic format (pdf).

Eurostat set up with all Member States a network of support centers. Their mission is to provide help and guidance to Internet users of European statistical data, thus to all users of Eurostat's website.
