

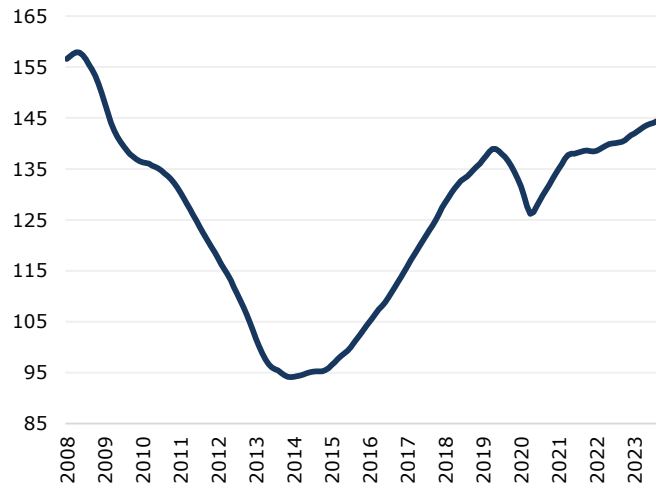

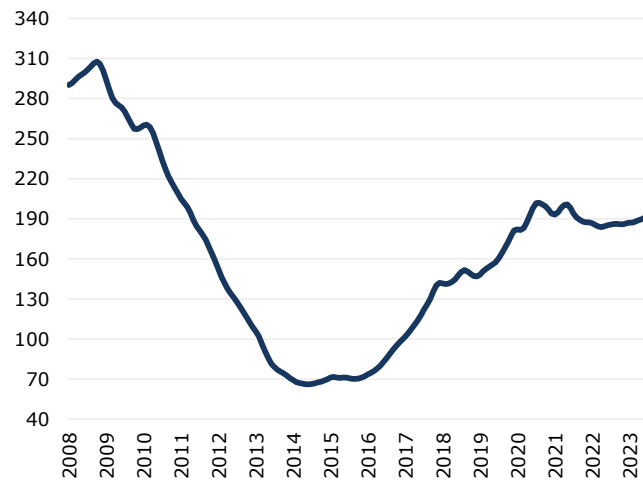
Volume Index of Manufacturing Production

Trend (2015=100)



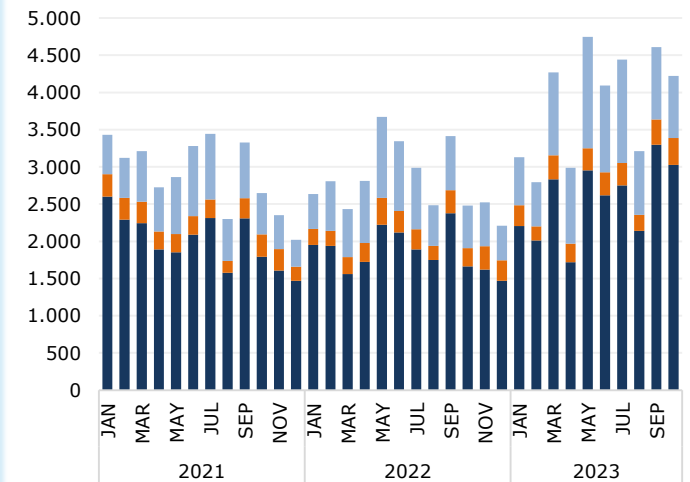
Building Permits Authorised

Trend (Thousand m²)



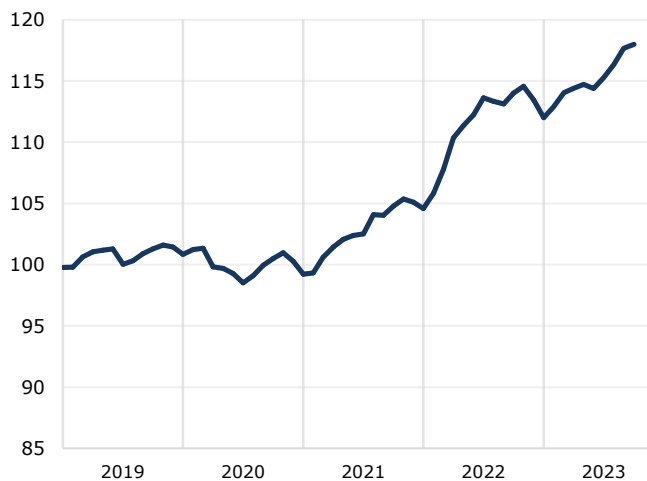
Registrations of Motor Vehicles

■ Private saloon ■ Light goods ■ Other vehicles



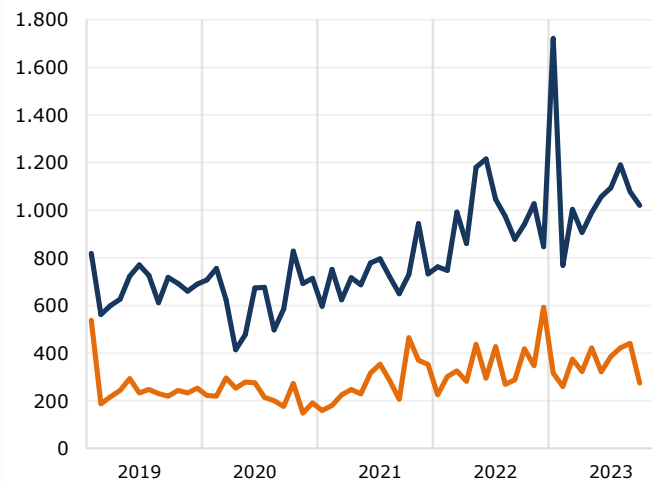
Consumer Price Index

(2015=100)



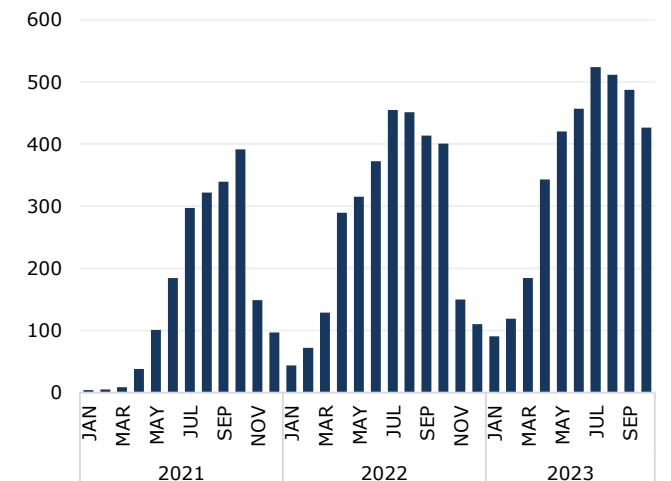
Foreign Trade: Imports - Exports
